  - A. City of San Diego Council District 4 Eric Henson discussed the FY22 budget (there will be more oversight in the SDPD overtime costs), the Parks Master Plan, the SANDAG Regional Transportation Plan, and the Utility Franchise Agreement, among other topics.
  - **B.** City of San Diego Council District 8 Eddie Padilla not in attendance
  - C. City of Can Diego Council District 9 Martha Zapata also discussed the City's budget (Stockton will get streetlights) and the creation of the Office of Child & Youth Success, summer programs for school kids, rest assistance still available from covid-19 funds, the Library Ready Program, and that D9 will have a virtual "meeting with the Mayor" on July 10 at 9:00 a.m.
  - **D.** City of San Diego Mayor's Office Matthew Griffith discussed the budget and reallocating some SDPD overtime funding toward homeless outreach, small business loans, getting people back to work post-covid, safe streets, and the State of California expected to reopen the state on June 15, 2021.

A. Project #648988 located at 3443 Pickwick Street, Marijuana Production Facility (MPF). The parcel at 3443 Pickwick is proposed to be added to the approved Conditional Use Permit (CUP) # 2063998 for a 1,920 square-foot expansion to the existing 3,500 square-foot MFP at 3433 Pickwick Street. Aaron recused himself from this item. The project at 3433 was previously reviewed and discussed at the SSDPG. By adding the project at 3443 Pickwick there will be more combined parking. All State and local laws are to be followed in this industrial area. Cannabis waste will be ground up, locked up, and picked up by a licensed waste management firm. Operating hours will be 7:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. The project will not add additional trips or traffic to the area. There will be three employees and a security guard during operating hours. *Motion to support adding 3443 Pickwick project to the 3433 Pickwick CUP. MSC Torio/Urguby 7-0-0.*

A. Chollas Creek South Branch Implementation Program and Chollas Creek Enhancement Program Updates

Presented by Abdirahman Buul, Environmental Projects Manager at Groundwork, <a href="www.groundworksandiego.org">www.groundworksandiego.org</a>, 619-543-0430, 858-260-8838 Abdirahman discussed having a Climate-Safe Neighborhood because there is heat and flooding in the area of the creek. A recent survey showed that 70% didn't enjoy the park because of illegal activities, overgrowth, poor lighting, and drug issues. 34% of survey respondents had flooding issues. "Tree San Diego" campaign is planting trees at multi-family housing. The "Eyes On The Creek" campaign is to encourage people who see something to say something. Neighbors events in April and May collected large amounts of trash. The next one will be on Saturday, June 26, 2021. The National Parks Service picked the I-15 Corridor Trail from Market Street to National Avenue for funding.

The CIP is the long-range plan for all individual capital improvement projects and funding sources. CIP Projects are unique construction projects that provide improvements or additions such as land, buildings, and infrastructure.
