Alvarado Creek/Grantville Trolley Station Enhancement Project final report

Planning Dept. asked to apply for SANDAG grant for Alvarado Creek flooding issues. Met grant deadline and schedule. Study completed (200 pages with appendices). Brought CD available to NCPI website. Feature on City of SD planning Dept. website. Plan to widen channel, enlarge culverts, and habitat restoration. Funding needed now to get complete design and implement the study. Study provides path forward. M. Adams ask timeframe to turn vision into actual project. Private property and one holdout (need all in agreement). What can NCPI do to help facilitate the project forward. We can endorse the study. D. Smith states Lisa did a hell of a job. Create an EFID District but need everyone on board. Hopes NCPI will support CEQA and other applications going forward. J. LaRaia asks if all property owner onboard what is next step. At 30% design

CEQA next step. Apply for Capital grants. M. Reed what is recreational corridor on plan? Shown in yellow on handout. J. Wilson compliments Lisa first project in long time actually on time. David Smith – passed out June statement (Navajo bank account) as generated thru development impact fees. 1.1 million left but not a lot compared to other planning groups. Since 1988 \$5 million total received. Money to spend on school, parks, libraries, etc. Need to focus in Grantville since that is only area left for development. M. Adams asks what \$800,000 for (Rancho Mission Park). Stormwater issues needed additional funding. M. Adams asks to do a quarterly update when it comes out and go down and testify at City Council meeting instead of sending letter. J. Wilson \$1.2 million original budget but stormwater as well as additional ADA requirements needed. David Smith request NCPI take initiative as to where 800,00 is going. T. Cords will assist. Dan Smith makes motion to have David Smith and Terry Cords examine and evaluate the additional \$800,000 cost to Rancho Mission Play area construction and report back 14-0 in favor. M. Adams seconds
