City Staff recommendation related to business signage in residential neighborhoods, as part the 11th Update to the Land Development Code

Staff Summary: specified commercial uses are allowed in some citywide residential zones such as schools, child care facilities, golf course, reuse of historical buildings and in the RM zones, a wider variety of retail/commercial/office uses are allowed. The sign regulations in Chapter 14, Article 2, Division 12, however, regulate signs based on zones and not uses. Because the sign regulations in residential zones tend to be more prohibitive that those of the commercial and industrial zones, the available signage for allowed commercial uses in residential zones is limited and may not even allow for some tenants to have any signs. The regulations should change to allow adequate signage for commercial uses that are allowed in residential zones.
