*RB Community Council Summary Report

- -The full board approved the annual Maintenance Assessment District budget
- -The Regional Task Force on the Homeless reached out to the Community Council to assist with volunteer coordination of helping to count and survey homeless individuals in the north county inland area. This process is called WeAllCount: http://www.rtfhsd.org/wp-content/uploads/2017/10/2018-WeAllCount-Flyer-Full-Page-NEW.pdf The full board approved this participation.
- -The full board approved a community flag design event. Individuals in each age category elementary, middle, high school, and adult will be able to submit a design that reflects our community. A non-Community Council individual will judge the submissions. One design in each age category will be picked. They will go on display at their schools and/or community centers, the library, in the median on RB Rd, at the Community Council's RB Alive booth and in the 4th of July parade.
- -The full board approved appointment of the annual election adhoc chairs.
- -The full board approved two amendments to the bylaws.
- -The full board discussed insurance costs and will vote on it next month.
