WE WILL DISCUSS THE FOLLOWING PROJECT PROJECT NAME: JUDSON LANE ROW VACATION

PROJECT NUMBER: 614638

An application has been filed with the City of San Diego for a (Process 5) Public Right of Way Vacation, to vacate a 50-foot wide public right –of- way dedicated as Judson Lane. Located in the center between two parcels at 2585 Judson Street. The 0.10-acre site is in the RM-1-1 (Residential-Multiple Unit) Base Zone, within the Linda Vista Community Plan Area and Council District 7.

PROJECT NAME: ULRIC STREET APARTMENTS PROJECT DEVELOPER: Community Housing Works

Ulric Street Apartments is a proposed new development of 96 family apartments on 1.47 acres infill site. It is located along Ulric Street and Waterman Court in the Linda Vista Community. The proposed unit mix includes studios, one, two and three-bedroom apartments and will be restricted to households earning 30-60% of the Area Median Income. Ulric Street Apartments includes a 4-story building with surface parking.

An application has been filed with the City of San Diego for a Conditional Use Permit/Neighborhood Development Permit/Site/ Development Permit, Process Four for a Wireless Communication Facility (WCF) consisting of a 35' tall faux eucalyptus tree supporting 6 panel antennas. 3 remote radio units and 2 surge suppressors. An equipment and storage building are also part of this project. Equipment for the WCF will be in a 146-square-ft enclosure and an attached 121-square foot room will provide storage for the park. The project is located in the Mission Heights Neighborhood Park at 7230 Acari Street in the OP-1-1 zone.
