ITEM #8 Short-Term Rentals:

On October 22, 2018, the San Diego City Council rescinded their previous action to implement regulations for short-term rentals. They took no further action, apparently leaving the use unregulated. It appears that the Mayor has already begun to work with various stakeholders on a new compromise plan. The Board will consider sending a letter to Councilmember Kersey requesting that he work with the Mayor to include stakeholders from all areas of the City in future discussions on this matter, including District 5, because this issue has potential effects on all areas of the City.
