Vidales/Hill 7-0-0. SUBCOMMITTEE MOTION 2: To oppose widening Texas St. from Camino Del Rio South to El Cajon Boulevard. The segment Texas St. from El Cajon Blvd. to Madison Ave. has single family homes with driveways, and it includes the recently designated "Melhorn and Son" Historic District. The outdated methodology of Level of Service (LOS) should not be the only methodology used to determine transportation impacts, and other methods should be used such as Vehicle Miles Traveled (VMT).
