

Linda Vista Planning Group (LVPG)

The Linda Vista Planning Group is officially recognized by the City of San Diego to advise and make recommendations to the City Council, the Planning Commission, City staff, and other governmental agencies on land use matters relating to the greater Linda Vista community.

The Linda Vista Planning Group created an ad hoc sub-committee on the development of the Riverwalk Golf Course that is in Mission Valley and borders Linda Vista. This ad hoc sub-committee is tasked to work with the Mission Valley Planning Group and the developer on issues of mutual community interest such as traffic, parking, pedestrian access and safety, and other relevant planning matters, and to make regular reports to the LVPG.

The Linda Vista Riverwalk Ad Hoc Sub-Committee will meet on Thursday, April 11, 2019 at 5:30 p.m. at the Linda Vista Library Community Room located at 2160 Ulric, San Diego.

The subcommittee will discuss the Riverwalk development plan as it has been presented to date; the pros and cons of the proposed development and the potential impacts of density, traffic, and parking on the residents of Linda Vista.
