 North Park Community Plan Amendment – East side of Florida Street between Cypress and Upas Streets. Planning Department is seeking the recommendation of the NPPC on a community plan amendment/rezone of about 4 acres along the east side Florida Street from Upas Street to Cypress Street. The focus area does not include parcels abutting Alabama Street. The 2016 North Park Community Plan Update unintentionally changed the plan land use designation from Residential – Medium-High (30 – 45 DU/acre) to Residential – Low (up to 9 DU/acre). The

proposed amendment will change the plan land use designation back to Residential – Medium-High (30 - 44 DU/acre) and the zoning to RM-3-7.
