Subject: Historic Designation of 2618 Myrtle Avenue in North Park

Dear Mr. Lin and Historical Resource Board members:

The North Park Historical Society supports the designation of 2618 Myrtle Avenue as a locally significant historic site. This site is an excellent example of a Mission Revival home in nearly original condition. In addition, it sits adjacent to the existing North Park Dryden Historic District, contrasting beautifully to the Craftsman homes that largely characterize that district. It also contrasts with the slightly newer bungalow court across the alley. Together, this designation with the adjacent parcels provide a range of housing common to San Diego in the first half of the 20th century. These resources provide a cross-section of the first half century of development in North Park in the neighborhood adjacent to Balboa Park.
