






Bicycle Program




Proposed Budget

- Coastal Rail Trail: \$50,000, construction start May 2025







Ciclovia Overview

- Ciclovia: A Spanish term meaning "Cycleway"
- Opening of the street to active transport
- Began in December 1974 in Bogotá, Colombia, where it has taken place every Sunday from 7:00 am to 2:00 pm
- Since spread to over 18 countries and 30 U.S. cities
 - At least 3 of which are hosted on a regular, recurring basis more than once per year
- San Diego has hosted approximately 10 events over 12 years and more within the region
