The continued discussion from the October CPC meeting resulted in the following motion that passed: CPC requests that the City looks into the capabilities for CPC to hold hybrid meetings; lacking such capabilities, the CPC requests to be allowed to continue to hold online meetings as well as allowing the option for online meeting software/hybrid/in person meetings for each CPG and their subcommittees.

- Move that the state amends the Brown Act to include online meeting software as options for meetings.
 - 2. <u>REQUEST TO MAINTAIN FEE FREE APPEALS:</u>

The recent CPG reforms have eliminated fee free appeals by Planning Groups. The CPC will discuss whether we want to pursue reinstating this practice.

The discussion resulted in the following motion that passed:

CPC requests that City Council provide each PG with the ability to appeal one project throughout the appeals process without fee per calendar year.
