Proposal for vacation of Public Service Easement due to relocation of services for Capital Improvement Program project "Sewer Group Job 691" on Assessor's Parcel Map Numbers 539-011-14-00, 539-011-24-00 and 539-011-25-00 near 29th Street and Kalmia Place. Sewer Group 691 started construction on January 22, 2015 and completed in November 9, 2017. The project included the installation of 4,450 linear feet of new sewer mains and the abandonment of 1,293 linear feet of sewer mains in canyons and easements.
