John LaRaia – Suggest we not hear Marijuana Co-op issues unless they already have a determination at next meeting.

Terry Cords – Happy New Year. Rec Council funding issue. City of SD appears to not have a single solution to problem. Apologizes to city attorney he does not agree with her opinion but she has done a good job. Park and Rec management incredibly slow on resolving issue. Money has to be given back to City and the City could bestow money back to Rec Councils. Fields looking good. Lewis field being refurbished. 1-17 2018 next San Carlos Rec Council meeting.

Dave Egg – 2 pm old town-new town history discussion. Get additional info from website.

#### **Informational Presentations:**

Pipeline Rehabilitation AN-1 Project - The project will rehabilitate 7.65 miles of old sewer mains, rehabilitate approximately 966 sewer service laterals, replace in place 717 linear feet of old sewer mains, replace in place 5 manholes, and the installation of 32 sewer main clean-outs. City of San Diego. Construction to start 6/18 and finish 11/2019. M. Adams asks what area contractors are starting in. Contractor will decide. Contractor not under contract yet. D. Livingston asks that City follow up and make sure contractor cleans up sites post construction. See attached handout.

# **Community Choice Energy:**

Briefing on Community Choice Energy proposal that would allow cities and counties to purchase power on behalf of their residents and businesses. SD Community Choice Alliance-Mr. Tyson Seagull and Sempra Service-Mr. Herman Collins and Peder Norby.

M. Adams asks about exit fee. What would it mean for average customer? How would bill change (say per month). Gone up 400% .5 cents per kilowatt hr. \$20-\$30 (Norby). Exit Fee – exists right now and all CCPs pay. Extra community put back into community not to shareholders. Renewable energies more expensive. KPBS says video shown by Sempra does not have facts straight.

Audience member asks who appoints CPUC members. The Governor does.

J. LaRaia asks about fees paid to Sempra for use of infrastructure. Infrastructure fees would be here but the cost savings would be in the purchase of energy on the open market.

The 22.9-acre project site is located at 6910-6980 Mission Gorge Road, excepting 6966 Mission Gorge Road, in the proposed OC-1-1, OP-2-1, RM-3-9, RM-4-10, and Community Plan Implementation Overlay Zone (Area A) within the Navajo Community Plan Area – Mark
