# **Weekend Traffic Advisory in Hillcrest for Pedestrian Bridge Construction Project**

## **ROAD CLOSURE WILL IMPACT ACCESS ON AND OFF STATE ROUTE 163 FROM SIXTH AVENUE**

SAN DIEGO – Starting on Saturday, May 13, at 5 a.m., the City of San Diego will be closing Sixth Avenue in both directions from State Route 163 to University Avenue for the construction of a pedestrian bridge over the street. This closure will remain in place until Monday, May 15, at 5 a.m. or until the construction is completed, whichever comes first.

Construction contractors with Scripps Mercy Hospital San Diego will be building a new pedestrian bridge over Sixth Avenue to connect the medical facility to a newly constructed parking structure. This pedestrian bridge will replace one that was removed in January 2022 as part of the same project.

Electronic signage has been posted for the past week notifying travelers of the closure and associated detours.
