Vista Lane Rezone/Tentative Map/Street Vacation Project is requesting a rezone, tentative map and street vacation for the creation of 3 lots located on Vista Lane between Via Las Tonalas and Beyer Blvd. This will allow the excess right of way build out of South Vista Lane and reservation for the existing City of San Diego water main. (The Planning Group previously voted this project in January 2001, with the motion passing 10-0.)
 Motion made by M. Freedman and Seconded by S. Gonzales to reaffirm previous vote to approve rezone/tentative map/street vacation. Motion Passed (12-0-0).
- b. <u>Vista Lane Villas</u> Re-submittal, Community Plan Amendment, Planned Development Permit, Rezone from RS-1-7 to RX-1-2 and Tentative Map to construct 38 units on a 1.919 AC site at 3481 Vista Lane. (Previous action by the Planning Group in November 2005, to recommend project move forward only under the RX-1-2 zone. Motion passed 9-2-0.) Filipe Roma and Daniel Conteras were present to answer questions. Consensus to continue item and authorize chair to send letter to Bill Anderson, City of San Diego City Planning & Community Investment and a letter to the Planning Commission regarding the zoning for this project as well as <u>Item c. Mission Villas</u> and "Item d<u>. Blackshaw Lane Villas</u>. City staff is has requested the developer to rezone the property as an RM-1-1 zone not the Planning Group recommended RX-1-2 zone. - f. Parking at Beyer Blvd. & Enright Dr. S. Gonzalez and A. Perez are requesting better supervision and parking enforcement of student pick up area and vehicular parking at SY Middle School driveway at Enright Drive. Street improvements have not continued for this area and are necessary. Graffiti is a continuing problem with kids leaving school. Neighbors have spoken with the principal and the school district but the problem continues. M. Paul has volunteered to meet with principal and neighbors to request additional supervision. No vote taken. D. Flores will send letter to Councilmember Hueso requesting City to create a "temporary" sidewalk.
- g. San Ysidro Hills James E. Schneider, representing property owners of San Ysidro Hills, requested a SYP&DG member be appointed to participate in drafting a "wish list" for community projects to be funded by an Infrastructure Financing District created by the San Ysidro Hills project. Property owners are currently negotiating with Brookfield Homes as developer of the proposed 4,000 housing unit project. The Infrastructure Financing District for projects within 3 miles of the international border. It was suggested that Mr. Schneider review the Facilities Financing Plan and the Redevelopment Implementation Plan for ideas on projects the community would like to see done. S. Otto and D. Flores volunteered to represent the Planning Group. Appointment of an official representative from the Planning Group will be added to the October 2006 agenda.
