- b. <u>Las Palmas EOT:</u> (Michael Rollins, Applicant). Extension of Time (3 years) for an approved Tentative Map and Site Development Permit to remove existing structures and construct 17 residential condominium units at 122 Alverson Road (APN 638-092-06/07/08). The 1.15 acre (50,094 sq. ft.) site is in the RM-1-1 zone. (On 4/18/2006, SYCPG recommended approval provided there will be onsite affordable housing.) (3/29/2007: approved by Planning Commission). Units range between 1700sf & 1900sf with private 2-car garages. Ms. Gonzalez expressed concern about increased traffic. Mr. Otto about sidewalk conditions, on-street parking, and narrow travel lanes. Mr. Flores thinks more transportation choices would help.
