- a. Water Purification Demonstration Project. City of San Diego. Marco Cortes of Cortes Communications and Fabiola Amorillas of the City of San Diego presented the project. The City of San Diego Water purification Demonstration Project is underway to examine the use of advanced water purification technology on high quality recycled wastewater. The Demonstration project will determine the feasibility of a full-scale Reservoir Augmentation project. See http://www.sandiego.gov/water/waterreuse/demo/. The Demonstration project is the second phase of a process evaluating ways for the City to increase its use of recycled water. The Reservoir augmentation is a multi-step process which includes using water purification technology on recycled water, sending the purified water to the San Vicente Reservoir to blend with existing water supplies and treating the blended water one more time before being distributed as drinking water. The Demonstration Project will conclude in early 2013. https://www.sandiego.gov/water/waterreuse/demo/.
- b. "Old" Otay Mesa Road Reconstruction: City of San Diego & Estrada Land Planning. The widening of "Old" Otay Mesa Road from Hawken Drive to south of Crescent Bay Drive, to provide for two lanes of travel, bike lanes in each direction and pedestrian paths. The project will realign the center line of the road, improve visibility and add a sidewalk on the north side of the street. Project is in early stage, so there will be more updates provided to SYCPG. **INFORMATION ITEM ONLY.**
