 - i. AH: bike thefts? A: around 1800 bike thefts in December, mostly within the context of residential burglaries.

 - **iii.** KH: how to get more money? A: shovel-ready projects can get leveraged.
 - iv. KK: leveraging? A: for instance for schools along the route (safe routes to schools).
 - **v.** NB: maintenance? A: falls to the city. For instance maintenance assessment districts. Big challenge.
