Starting Pay:

- \$19.59 Pool Guard I (16+)
- Candidates receive paid training once they've successfully completed a medical and background check, and have signed employment paperwork

Qualification Test:

- Tread Water for two minutes using your legs only
- Swim 20 yards, surface dive 7-10
 ft. to retrieve a 10 lb object. Swim
 20 yds on your back to return to
 the starting wall while holding the
 object with both hands and with
 your face out of the water. Climb
 out without using the ladder or
 stairs. All to be completed within
 1 minute 40 seconds.
- Continuous 300 yd swim (12 lengths, no stopping)
- 1. Submit online application (must be 16 years old or older).
- 2. Attend a hiring tryout. Receive information on scheduling onboarding appointments upon accepting a position.
- 3. Attend a Pool Guard Training course and obtain certification within 90 days of hire.
