**Subject:** Elected Official Guides for City Councilmembers

On December 6, 2006, the City Council approved a comprehensive financial training program developed by the IBA in response to a request from the Council President. The adopted financial training program is intended to provide current and future Councilmembers with multiple sources of relevant information on the important areas of government finance. Resolution R-302243 directed the IBA to implement the financial training program described in IBA Report # 06-59.

One component of the adopted financial training program was to provide useful informational resources to the City Council. IBA Report # 06-59 described an excellent and extensive series of Elected Official Guides, offered by the Government Finance Officers Association, covering many important areas of municipal finance. The IBA has procured a complete set of the Elected Official Guides for each City Council office (attached). There is a guide booklet covering each of the following 21 financial subject areas:

- Debt Issuance
- Defined Benefit and Defined Contribution Retirement Plans
- Economic Development

- Risk Management
- Tax Increment Financing
