Potential Charter Amendments on Mayor & Council Salary Setting

OVERVIEW

On July 15, 2008 the City Council will be presented with two potential ballot measures, as directed by the Rules Committee during their discussion on May 28, 2008. These proposals would modify the current process by which salaries are set through a recommendation by a Salary Setting Commission and voted on by the City Council. Both proposals tie the Mayor and Council salaries to an outside benchmark and limit the authority the Council has to modify the resulting salaries. This report provides some examples of potential salaries that would be established if either of these ballot measures was approved by the voters.

FISCAL/POLICY DISCUSSION

Under one proposal (the "Madaffer/Young proposal"), Council and Mayoral salaries would be tied to the <u>salaries</u> of Superior Court judges. The ordinance at Council specifies 75% for Council Members and 100% for the Mayor. As of FY 2008, Superior Court judges were paid \$178,789. 75% is equal to \$134,092. Should the Council wish to consider other percentages to establish as benchmarks the IBA provides the following table to illustrate the dollar amounts:

The other proposal (the "Frye proposal") includes a specified increase factor for two years (either 3% or 5%) and then matches subsequent increases to the judge's enacted **raises**, not to exceed 5% per year. The IBA has illustrated the resulting salaries for the Mayor and City Council in the table below. In addition, we have provided the resulting salary for the City Attorney as that position has been included in the discussion of proposals at past hearings, as well. For purposes of projection, the IBA has used the average raise judges have received since FY 2000, which has been 3.9%.
