MIXED USE REGULATIONS – Action Item

Renee Mezo, Development Project Manager, will present the Mixed Use Regulations which will be an addition to Chapter 13 of the San Diego Municipal Code. The proposal includes two broad categories of zones, RMX (residential mixed use) and EMX (employment mixed use). The zones are set up for primary and secondary uses with increasing density and heights and a variety of formats and mixture of uses. During future rezone actions, the RMX/EMX zones would be available for use citywide within Transit Priority Areas. This measure will not replace any existing zones.
