INDIVIDUALS WITH SPECIAL NEEDS

All classes or programs can accommodate individuals with special needs. For programs that are contracted by the City of San Diego Parks and Recreation Department, Therapeutic Recreation Services will provide inclusion aides as additional assistance along with contractual program staff. Inclusion aides will be provided only upon availability. Requests for this service must be made at least three weeks prior to the first day of the program.

Rental programs are required to provide reasonable accommodations for individuals with disabilities. Contact program provider to discuss accommodations.

CONTRACTUAL VS RENTAL PROGRAM

The Carmel Valley Recreation Center offers a variety of programs for the youth which are provided through the means of two different sources: Contractual programs and Rental programs. Contractual programs consist of independent contractors that have been approved by the City of San Diego as a sponsored program. Rental programs are commercial companies that rent out the facility to offer their programs and activities for the community.

Requirements for Independent Contractors:

- All contractors, sub-contractors and volunteers must be fingerprinted through the City of San Diego Live Scan Process.
- City staff handles all registration for the program
- Contractors must submit a business license and proof of insurance
- Contractors must provide Worker's compensation coverage for all their Employees

Requirements for Permit Holders/Rental Programs:

Must provide proof of insurance
Must provide own advertisement for program
Handles all registration for their programs

Rental programs are NOT required to submit proof of fingerprinting for their coaches, volunteers and/or instructors.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Registration Begins: Saturday, May 11, 2024 at 10:00 am

Only a parent or legal guardian can register participants under the age of 18 years.

Cash or paper check is not accepted for registration.

Acceptable payment methods (on-line and in-person) include:

Electronic check - proper ID with proof of checking account (blank or voided check) required

Credit, debit, or gift cards issued by qualified card service merchants (Visa, MasterCard,

American Express, and Discover only).

A \$25.00 fee will be charged for declined electronic checks. All customers must verify that bank routing and account numbers are entered correctly.

All fees must be paid in full prior to attending the first class.

Classes not meeting the minimum number of students may be cancelled.

PROCESSING FEES ARE INCLUDED

All registration and reservation fees include a non-refundable 3.56% processing fee.

RECREATIONAL PROGRAMS REFUND AND TRANSFER POLICY

Written refund applications must be submitted, using the Application for Miscellaneous Refund Form (COM-6), in person at the facility where the program occurs. Refunds will be processed in accordance with the following policy:

Refund Policy Exclusions:

Three percent (3.56%) processing fee will be deducted from all refunds

No refund or transfer for non-attendance at any class

No credits to account

No refunds for costumes or equipment

Activity fees less than \$10.00 will not be refunded

Classes: Refund is based on the date that the written application is submitted.

96.5% refund - 3 or more calendar days prior to the first day of the class

75% refund - less than 3 calendar days prior to the first day of class

No refund for requests submitted more than 24 hours after the first day of class

Camps: Refund is based on the date that the written application is submitted.

96.5% refund - 10 or more calendar days prior to the first day of camp

50% refund - less than 10 calendar days prior to the first day of camp

No refund or transfer for requests less than 48 hours prior to the first day of camp*

Leagues: Refund is based on the date that the written application is submitted.

96.5% refund - 10 or more calendar days prior to the first scheduled game

50% refund - less than 10 calendar days prior to the first scheduled game

No refund or transfer for requests after the first scheduled game

Swimming Lessons: No refunds unless swimming lessons are cancelled by City staff. Transfer to another class may be permitted by the Pool Manager, at their sole discretion. No refund for emergency closure due to pool contamination.

One-day Activity/Field Trips: Refund is based on the date that the written application is submitted.

96.5% refund - 20 or more calendar days prior to the Activity or Field Trip

No refund for requests submitted less than 20 calendar days prior to the Activity or Field Trip.

Permit Refund Policy

Written refund applications must be submitted, using the Application for Miscellaneous Refund Form (COM-6), in person at the facility where the permit is issued. Refund will be processed in accordance with the cancellation/refund procedures as stated in the Parks & Recreation Fee Schedule. A 3.56% processing fee will be deducted from all refunds.

- 1) League Reservations for Fields and Indoor/Outdoor Courts: Refund is based on the date that the written cancellation/refund application is submitted.
 - 96.5% refund - 14 or more calendar days prior to the first scheduled use
 - No refund for requests received less than 14 calendar days prior to the first scheduled use
 - Field and Court Reservation Fees are non-refundable
- 2) Grounds Use Fees: Refund is based on the date that the written cancellation/refund application is submitted.
 - 96.5% refund (less \$50) - 60 calendar or more days prior to the event
 - No refund for requests submitted less than 60 calendar days prior to the event
- 3) Outdoor Court (except leagues) and Kumeyaay Campground: Refund is based on the date that the written cancellation/refund application is submitted.
 - 96.5% refund - 14 calendar days or more prior to use
 - No refund for requests submitted less than 14 calendar days prior to use
- 4) Building, Field, Picnic Shelter, Recreation Center Fund Fees and All Other Permit Rentals (not identified above): Refund is based on the date that the written cancellation/refund application is submitted.
 - 96.5% refund - 30 calendar days or more prior to use
 - 75% refund - less than 30 calendar days prior to use
 - 50% refund - less than 10 calendar days prior to use
 - No refund for requests less than 48 hours prior to use
- 5) Pool Rentals: Refund is based on the date that the written cancellation/refund application is submitted.
 - 96.5% refund - 14 or more calendar days prior to use
 - 75% refund - 48 hours or more prior the first day of a monthly rental
 - Late cancellations will be charged 25% of the fee paid

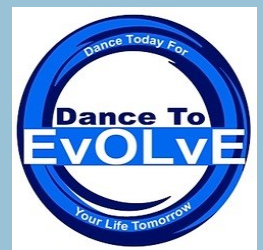

- * The only devices allowed in a skate park facility are skateboards, roller-skates, roller-blades, and in-line skates. Any other devices, including but not limited to bicycles, scooters, and motorized vehicles are unlawful to use in a skate park facility.
- * Skaters must be in full safety equipment to enter: Helmets, Elbow and Knee Pads designed for skateboarding
- * Visitors/Spectators not skating are required to remain outside fenced area
- * No smoking, alcohol, food or drink, or glass containers allowed inside the skate park
- * Littering and graffiti are not permitted
- * Unauthorized ramps, jumps or obstacles cannot be used inside or outside the skate park area.
