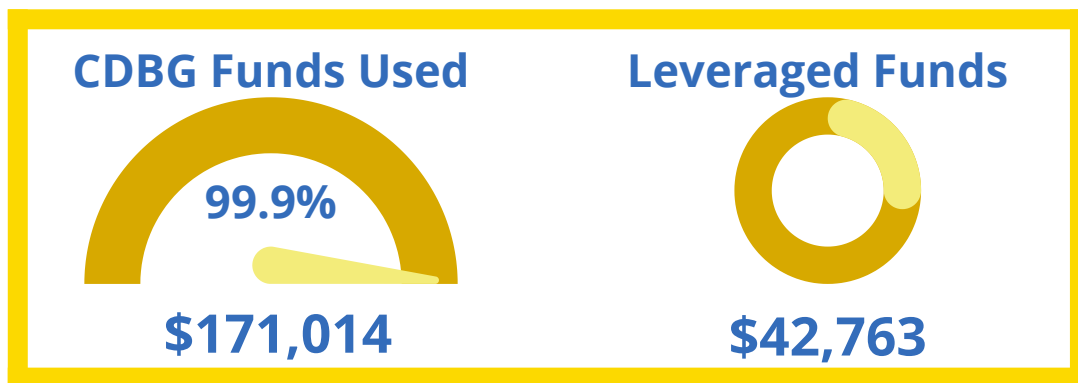

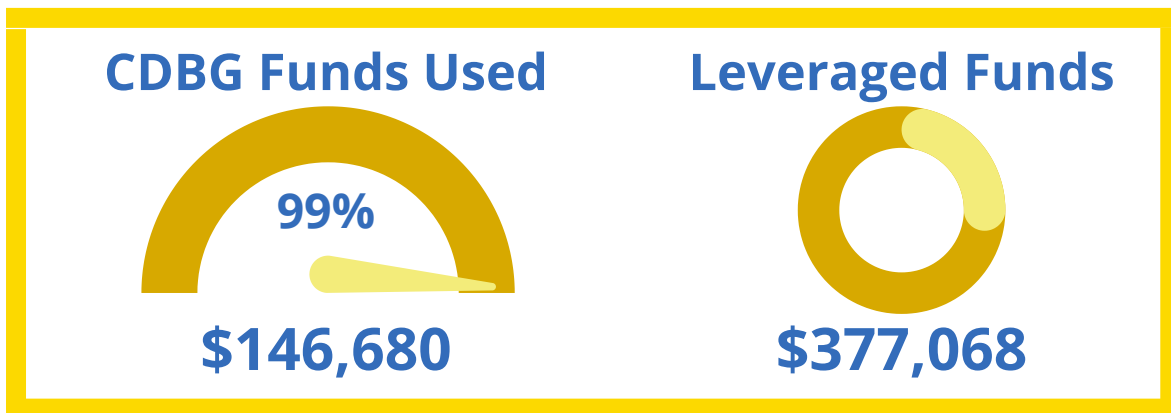

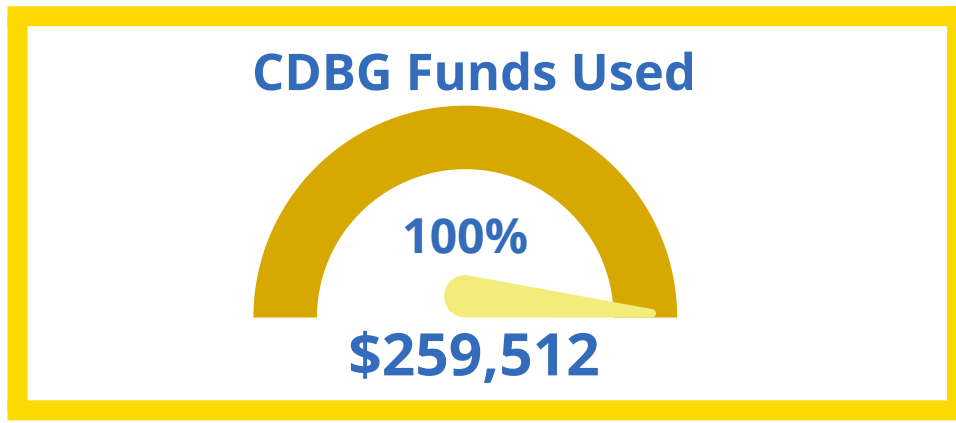

**35** microenterprise businesses established or expanded for the purpose of creating economic opportunity for LMI residents within the City of San Diego.

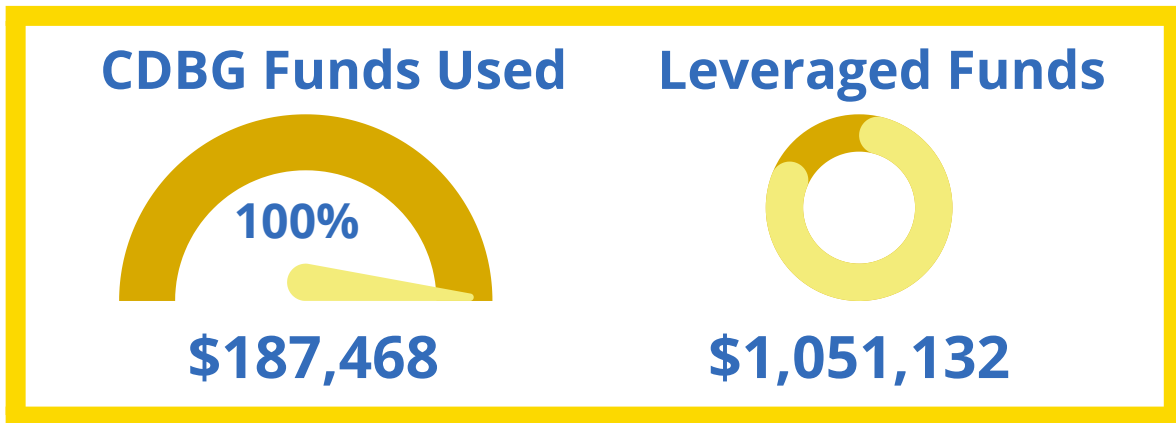
