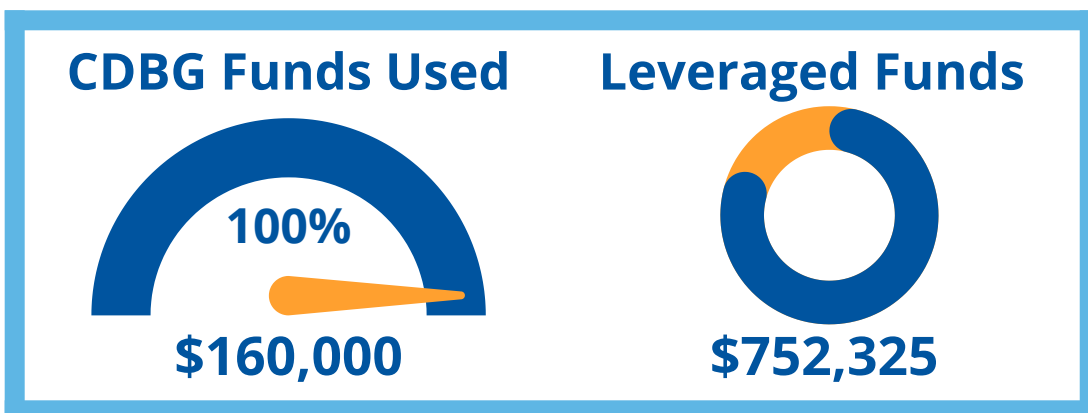


FY21 CDBG Workforce Development Project PROJECT LAUNCH

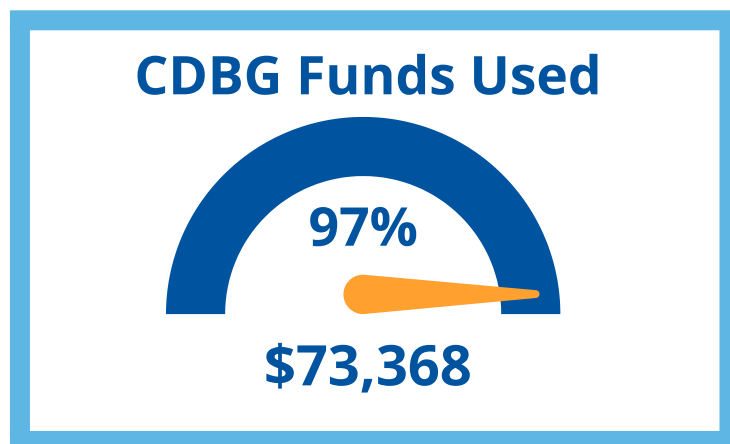

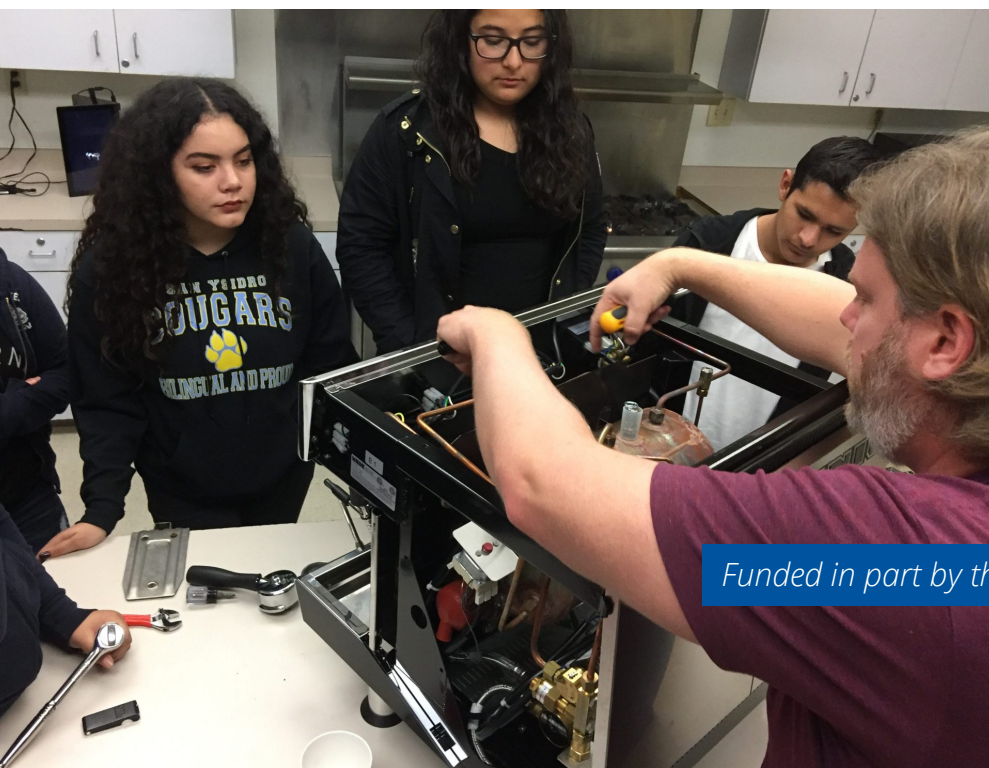
