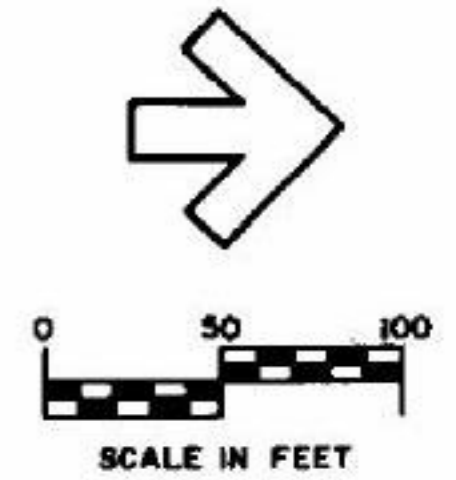


LOCATION MAP


