PARKS & RECREATION STAFF REPORT:

Recreation Center Director Mari Jo Ricanor reported the following for Cesar Chavez Community Center:

- A Drive Thru Halloween Event took place on October 27. Staff distributed 340 candy treat bags. Staff thanked SDPD and CD8 staff for volunteering during the event.
- Free youth dinner service is offered Monday through Friday from 5:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. for youth ages 18 and younger. Service will run until the beginning of summer.
- Staff is currently coaching 10 & under and 12 & under flag football teams at South Bay Recreation Center. The playoffs will start November 17.
- Staff is coaching a Pee Wee flag football team at Silverwing Recreation Center with league ending November 18.
- Staff is offering Adult Aerobics classes Tuesdays and Thursdays in the gym from 6:30 to 7:30 p.m.

- The annual Turkey Trot event will be held on November 23 at 12:00 p.m. at Larsen Field.
- Toys for Tots registration are ongoing and will end on December 9.

Assistant Recreation Center Director Jennifer Vaupel reported the following for San Ysidro Community Activity Center:

- Staff held a drive-up Halloween event on October 26. Staff distributed 300 treat & activity bags. Staff also handed out program guides and registered families for Toys for Tots.
- Staff will begin registering for youth basketball at the end of flag football season.
- Staff is coaching a 17 & under volleyball team at Martin Luther King Jr. Recreation Center on Thursdays.
- Staff is coaching a 12 & under flag football team on Wednesdays at South Bay Recreation Center.
- Marissa's dance classes resumed on Wednesdays this month and are conducted outdoors.
- Staff is currently holding a Virtual Yoga class on Mondays.
- Staff is accepting Toys for Tots registrations until November 19. Currently, staff has registered 40 families.
- Staff distributed Parks and Recreation paid internship opportunities flyers. The flyer includes information on an upcoming virtual Job Fair to be held November 17.

Area Manager Erek Estrada reported on the following for the San Ysidro area:

- Reported the recent promotions of Parks and Recreation personnel for the classifications of Recreation Center Directors and Assistant Recreation Center Directors.
- Assistant Recreation Center Director Jennifer Vaupel has accepted a job in Peoria Arizona and her last day will be November 19.
- Enrique Duran is the new District Manager for District 42 and will start his new assignment on November 2.
- Grounds Maintenance staff are working on a beautification landscaping project surrounding Vista Terrace Pool. Completion date is November 11.
- Beautification landscaping projects are also taking place at Vista Pacifica Neighborhood Park, Larsen Field and San Ysidro Community Park.
- A sinkhole was discovered in the area of the Fruit tree project at SYCP. Repairs are being made and should be completed in a couple weeks.
- San Ysidro Teen Center is nearly completed. Furnishings and recreation equipment have been ordered.
- Albert Hara is the interim District Manager, OCA for District 42.
- Beyer project continues to discuss vehicle access road for the first phase of park development.
- Staff is working closely with SDPD to address the recent memorial vigil/mural at the SYCP. Several illegal incidents have occurred which has delayed the process of removing the memorial. Staff will be notified by SDPD when the area is safe for clean up and removal of memorial items.
