## **COUNCIL DISTRICT 8 REPORT:**

Recreation Center Director Robert Lara reported on behalf of Council District 8 Representative Alondra Gonzalez:

• City's Transportation Department will be working on a lighting project along San Ysidro Blvd.

• The San Diego Humane Society will hold a 'Pup' Up event at La Mirada Elementary, Joint Use Field on October 1<sup>st</sup> from 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. Free services for pets include pet supplies, microchipping and low-cost vaccines for dogs and cats. No appointment necessary. Services are open to the first 50 pets.

## **SPORTS ORGANIZATIONS REPORTS:**

Felipe Muro of 'Comsports' informed everyone that they are preparing for their upcoming sporting events. Villa Cup will take place on November 19-20 and Villa Cup will take place on February 18-19, 2023. He is working with park staff on determining site locations for these events.

## **COMMUNITY ORGANIZATIONS REPORTS:**

Consuelo Delgadillo of 'Helping Hands Working Together' informed everyone food distribution events being held in San Ysidro. Food distribution is free of charge with the following locations offering the event monthly:

- 1st Tuesday of the month at Mt. Carmel Church from 8:30 to11:00 a.m.
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Friday of the month at Las Americas Parking Lot from 8:00 to11:00 a.m.
- Emergency food distribution at 3:00 to 5:00 p.m. daily at San Ysidro Chamber of Commerce, 603 East San Ysidro Blvd.

Juan Lopez of 'A.I.C.I.' reported the following:

- Participants in senior karaoke program are having a difficult time finding parking in the parking lot due to an increase of cars parking in the lot for a long period of time.
- The group will hold a Fiestas Patrias at the San Ysidro Senior Center on September 15 from 5:00 to 9:45 p.m. Activities will include karaoke, music, dance, and a mariachi band performance. Food tickets will be sold for \$10.00, and proceeds will benefit program activities for the San Ysidro Senior Center.

## PARKS & RECREATION STAFF REPORT:

Area Manager Kathy Costello of Aquatics requested feedback from everyone regarding the Vista Terrace Pool's Unfunded Park Improvement's list. She wanted to get ideas and suggestions to add to the list that would improve the overall operations of the pool. Discussion included providing shade coverings, demolishing, and creating a new building and pool, installing new security fencing and expanding the facility.

Recreation Center Director Mari Jo Ricanor reported the following for Cesar Chavez Community Center:

- Teen Nits ended August 26. 8-week event was a success with an average attendance of 67 teen participants.
- Movies in the Park was held on July 22 along with Teen Nite event. There were 172 who attended the dual event.
- Free meals to youth up to 18 years old started August 29 and will continue until summer 2023, unless there is a drop in attendance. These dinner meals are served at from 5:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday through Friday.

- Futsal and softball ended on September 2. Staff coached pee wee, 10u and 12u futsal teams and a 12u Girls' softball team. The 12u team will advance and play in the citywide tournament on September 17. The pee wee team will also play in an exhibition game. Games will be held at Balboa Park Municipal Gym.
- Staff is now taking registration for flag football starting in October. Ages divisions will be pee wee, 10u, 12u and 14u division teams. Practices will take place at Larsen Field and games will be held at Silverwing and South Bay Recreation Centers.
- Circus Alegria will be staging performances at Larsen Field from September 29 to October 7. Ticket sales will benefit Cesar Chavez Community Center and the San Diego Parks Foundation. More information will be reported at next month's meeting.
- On September 22, staff will accompany 25 teens to the annual Haunted Trails at Balboa Park. The event is free and open to the first 25 teens ages 12 to 17 years old.

Recreation Center Director Belinda Fimbres reported the following for San Ysidro Teen Center:

- San Ysidro Teen Center will take 10 teens in a van to the Haunted Trails at Balboa Park.
- Staff will offer a wide variety of fall themed activities during the 2-week school break.
- Staff will host in October a Día de los Muertos event.

Recreation Center Director Robert Lara reported the following for San Ysidro Community Activity Center:

- Staff coached pee wee, 10u and 12u futsal teams which participated in leagues held at Silverwing and South Bay Recreation Centers. 12u team will compete in quarter finals on Wednesday. Winner will advance to play at Citywide tournament on September 17 at Balboa Park Municipal Gym. Pee wee team will also play in an exhibition game.
- Sandbags are available free of charge at the recreation center for storm preparedness. Sand is not included; however, staff will be working in obtaining this resource if demand is needed.
- Staff is taking 25 teens to the Haunted Trails at Balboa Park on September 22. Sign up is on a first come, first serve to the first 25 teens ages 12 to 17 years old.
- Staff is offering a flag football program to pee wee, 10u and 12u age divisions. Games will be held at Silverwing and South Bay Recreation Centers.
- San Ysidro Community Activity Center will host voting polls in November.
