#### **AGENDA ITEMS:**

#### 1. CALL TO ORDER/MODIFICATIONS TO THE AGENDA:

Vice Chair Nick called the meeting to order at 6:15 p.m. and roll call was conducted. Modification made to the agenda without objection by David Moty for informational item on City Clerk proposal to improve access to Municipal Code.

# 2. BOARD COMMENT:

David: Technical advisory committee is meeting tomorrow on integrating Acella with code enforcement. Meeting is Zoom only.

David: Regarding CPG submissions to the city, a new document was added to the application: Operating Procedures replaces Terms and conditions.

Guy: There is no city presence at the committee and committees are not well known in the public. Rewriting bylaws too often is wasting CPG time.

Chip: There is a disjoint between demographic ask in application and what is in terms and conditions and policy.

Chip: Can groups take donations? Nick: Yes.

Korla: Has city rep at all meetings

Eastern Area: Used paper-based anonymization. Many others agreed with method.

Nick: Correction to agenda going forward to have Bannock Avenue

Paul: Read points from list of proposed changes to terms and conditions which will be up for ratification by NHCPG.

Nick: Land Development Code meeting moves to Jan. Andrea will be attending a code update meeting next week. HAP 2.0 going before City Council Nov 13.

#### 3. NON-AGENDA PUBLIC COMMENT:

Larry Turner: with the Police Dept. running for mayor introduces self.

Tom Mullany: Points out ministerial process. DIF fees have been reviewed by a grand jury and appear to be illegal. Would like to have a subcommittee to provide comments.

Becky Rapp: Update on SEED program expanding cannabis storefronts.

Wally Wulfeck: 20th anniversary of the Cedar Fire. Please ask communities to check and/or update fire insurance. Also oppose construction in very high fire hazard zones.

Matt Wahlstrom: Meetings by City are done as presentations without input. Community input meetings are not attended by the City. Volunteer code enforcement by community organizations is no longer encouraged. City has never changed position or actions based on community input.

Guy: Showed UT insert regarding planning groups.

Mission Beach: ADU can be sold as a condo now, does it need to be detached?

Tom: Ordinance regarding fire safety.

Nick: There is a lack of fire stations.

Victoria: New law regarding fire control perimeters. Some discussion on details.
