ITEM #8 - 12:45 SANDAG's Automated People Mover (APM) concept to connect Downtown with the airport. With a population projected to grow by up to 50,000, Mission Valley needs as much Green Line frequency as possible, as soon as possible. However, the Airport Trolley will [merge](#) onto the existing Blue/Green Line tracks, creating a bottleneck that would limit MTS' ability to increase Blue and Green Line frequency. By contrast, an APM would not share tracks with any existing Trolley lines, freeing up track capacity to maximize Green Line frequency. AlexWong, RideSD Data Researcher.
