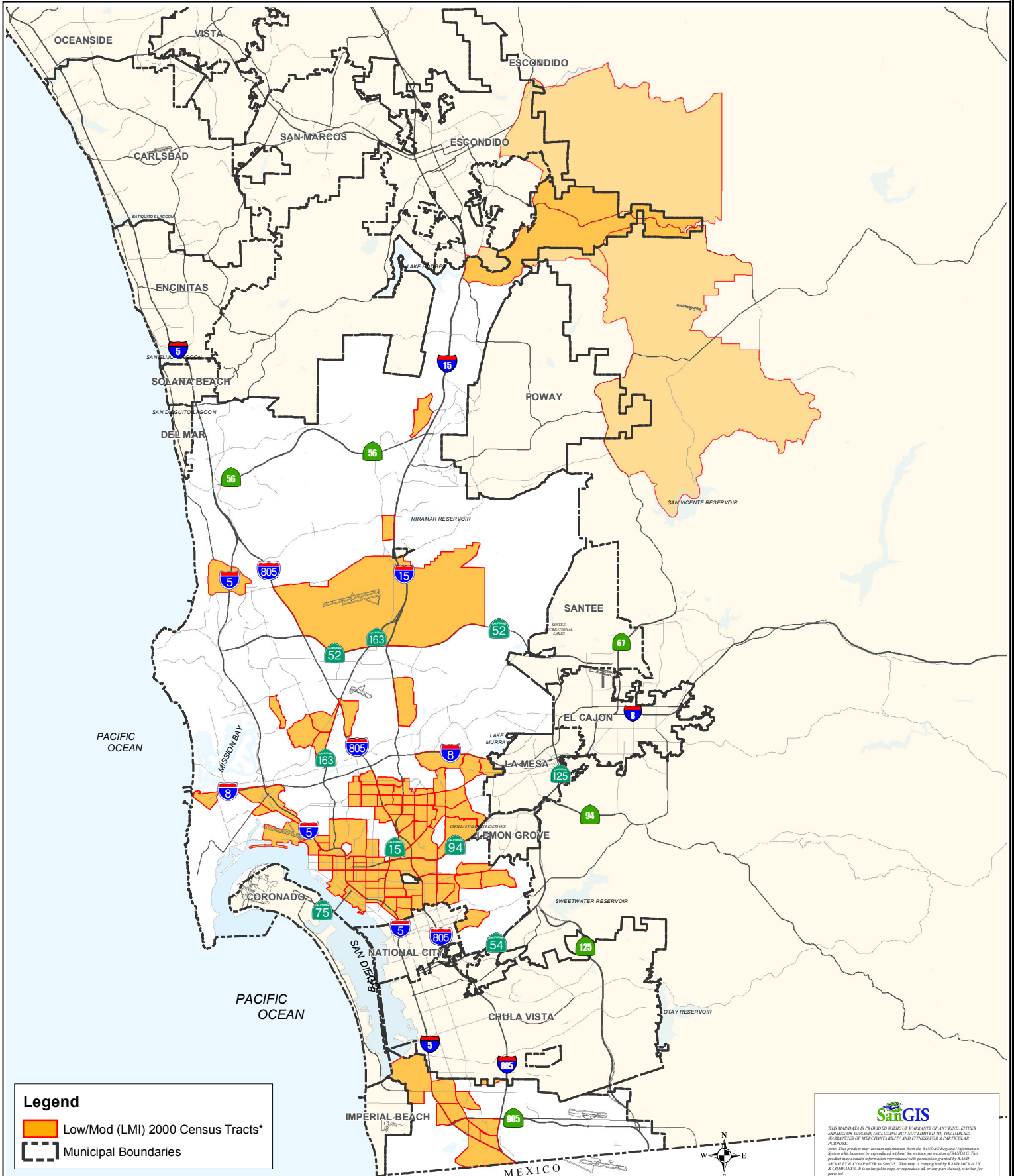

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# FY 2014 Low/Moderate Income Census Tracts\* with the City of San Diego

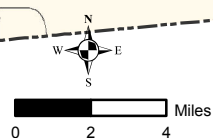

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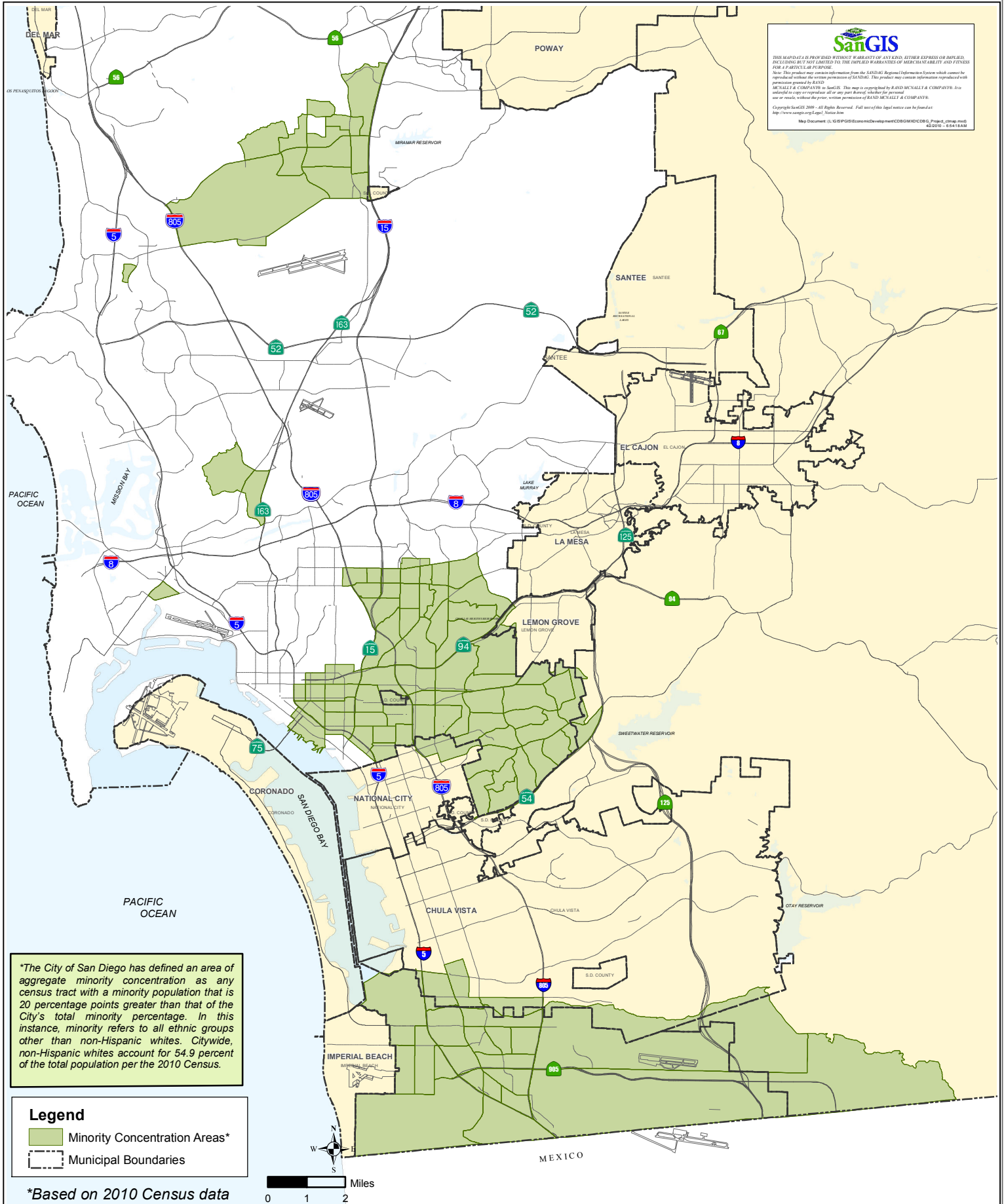
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# FY 2014 Areas of Minority Concentration\* within the City of San Diego

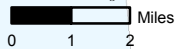

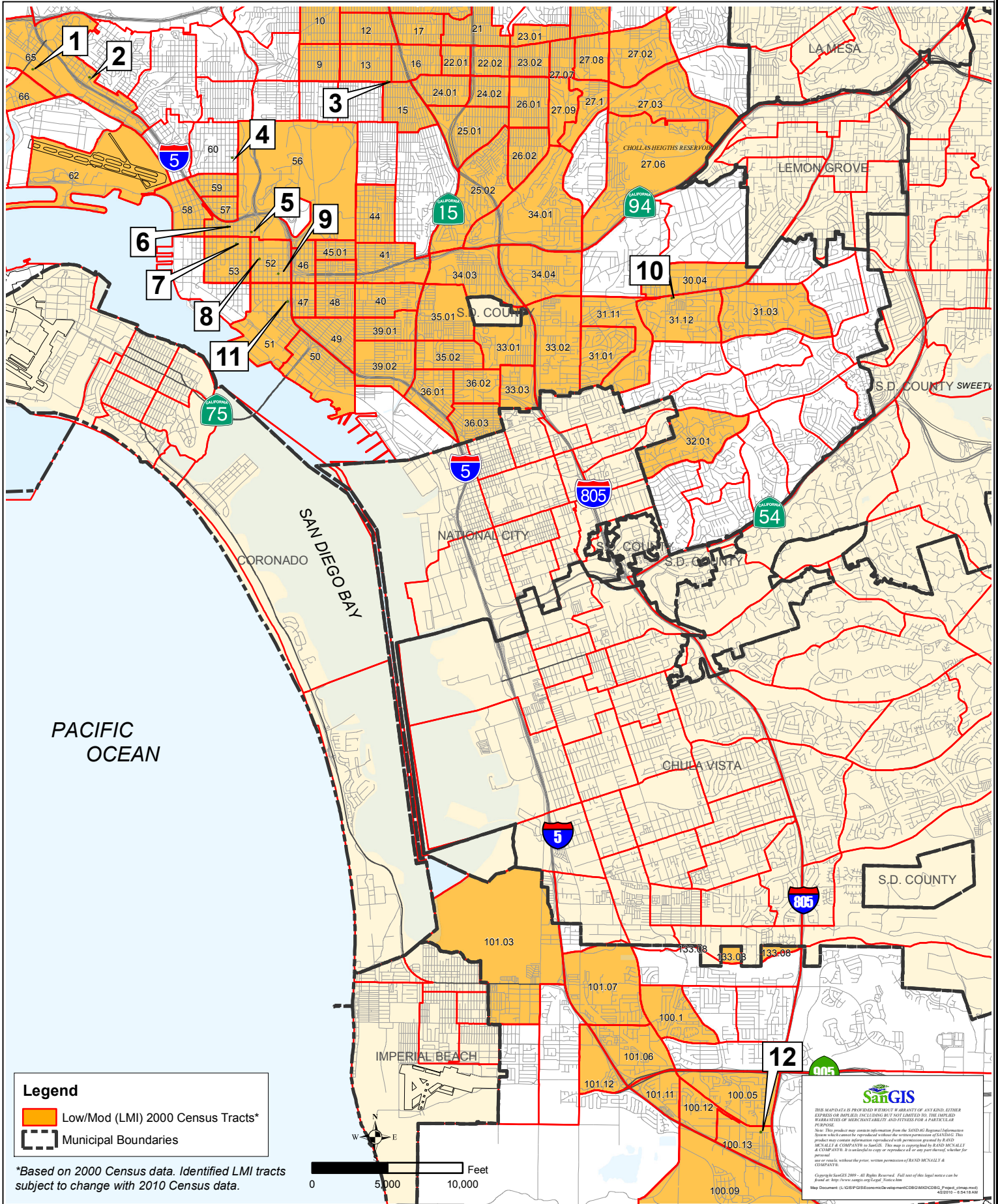

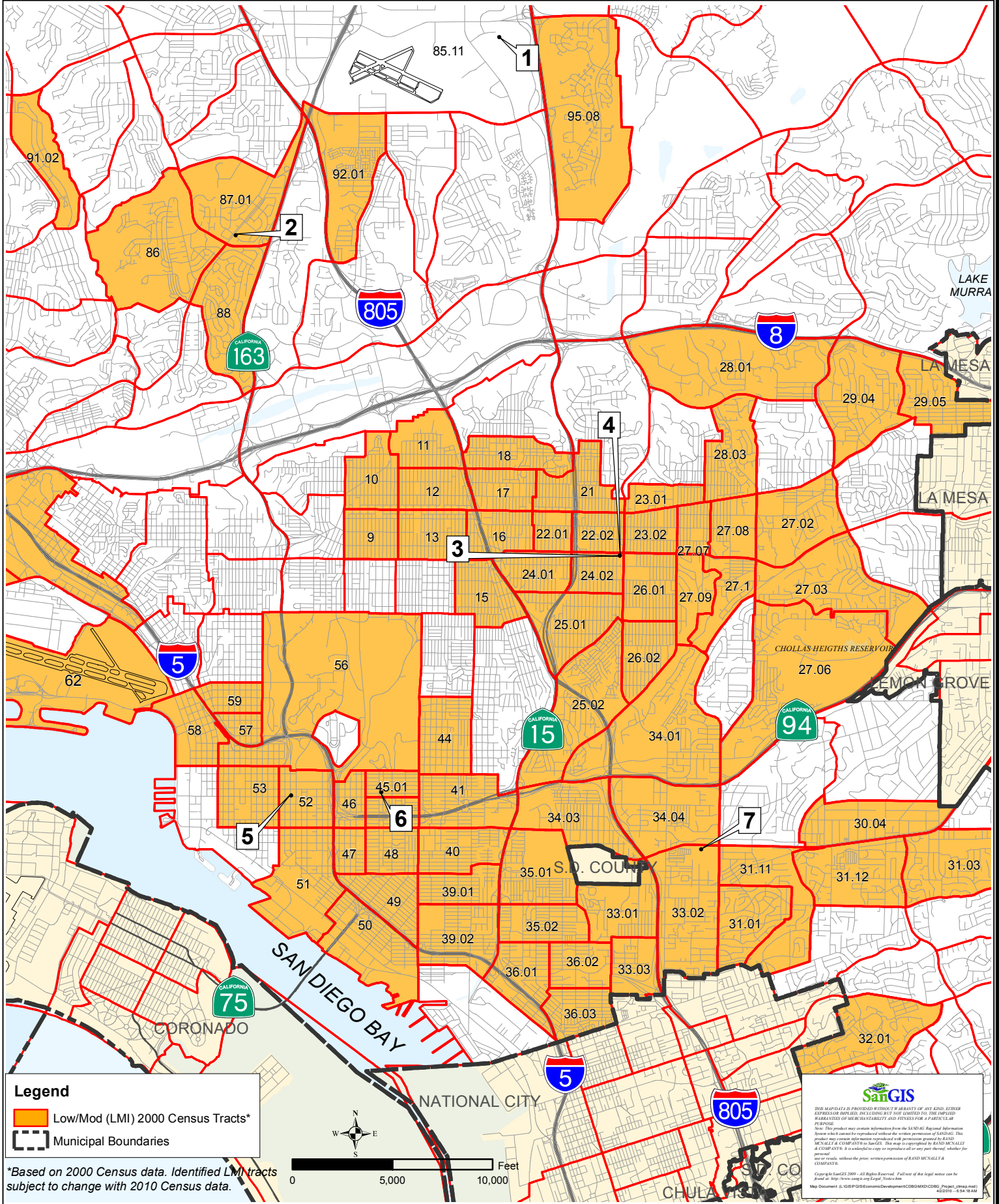

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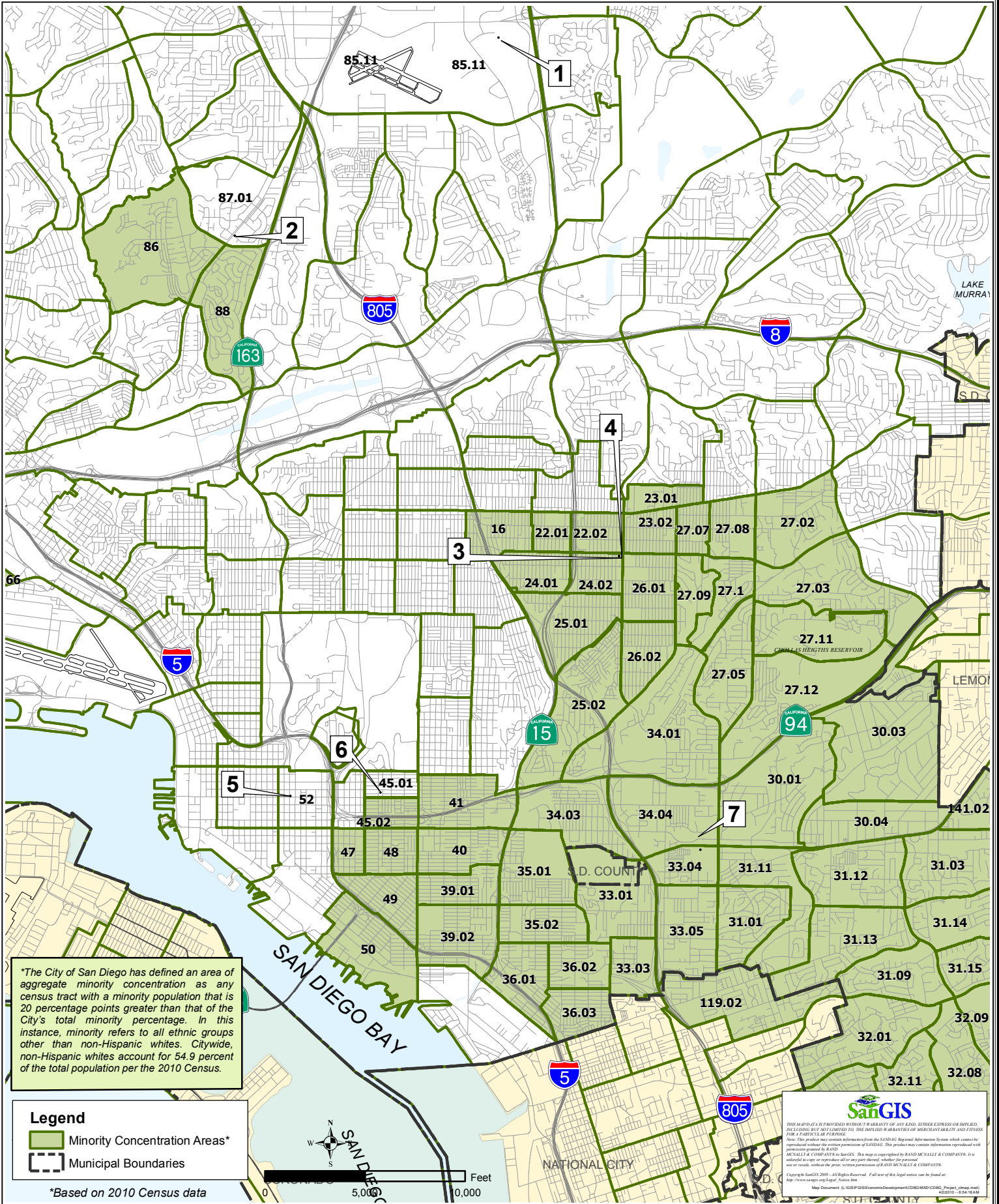


# FY 2014 CDBG Program Locations Relative to Areas of Minority Concentration\*

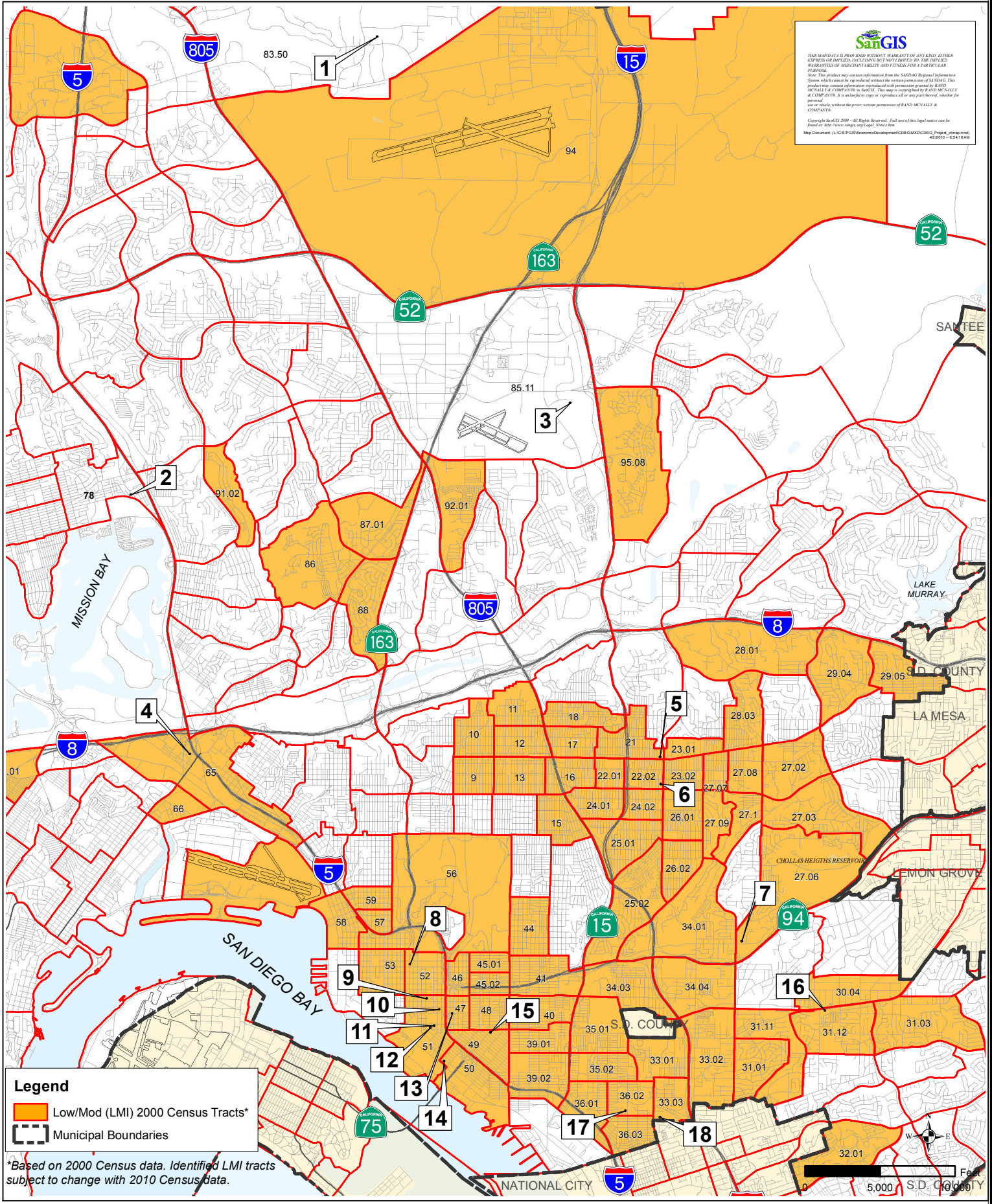


# FY 2014 CDBG Program Locations Relative to Low/Moderate Income Census Tracts

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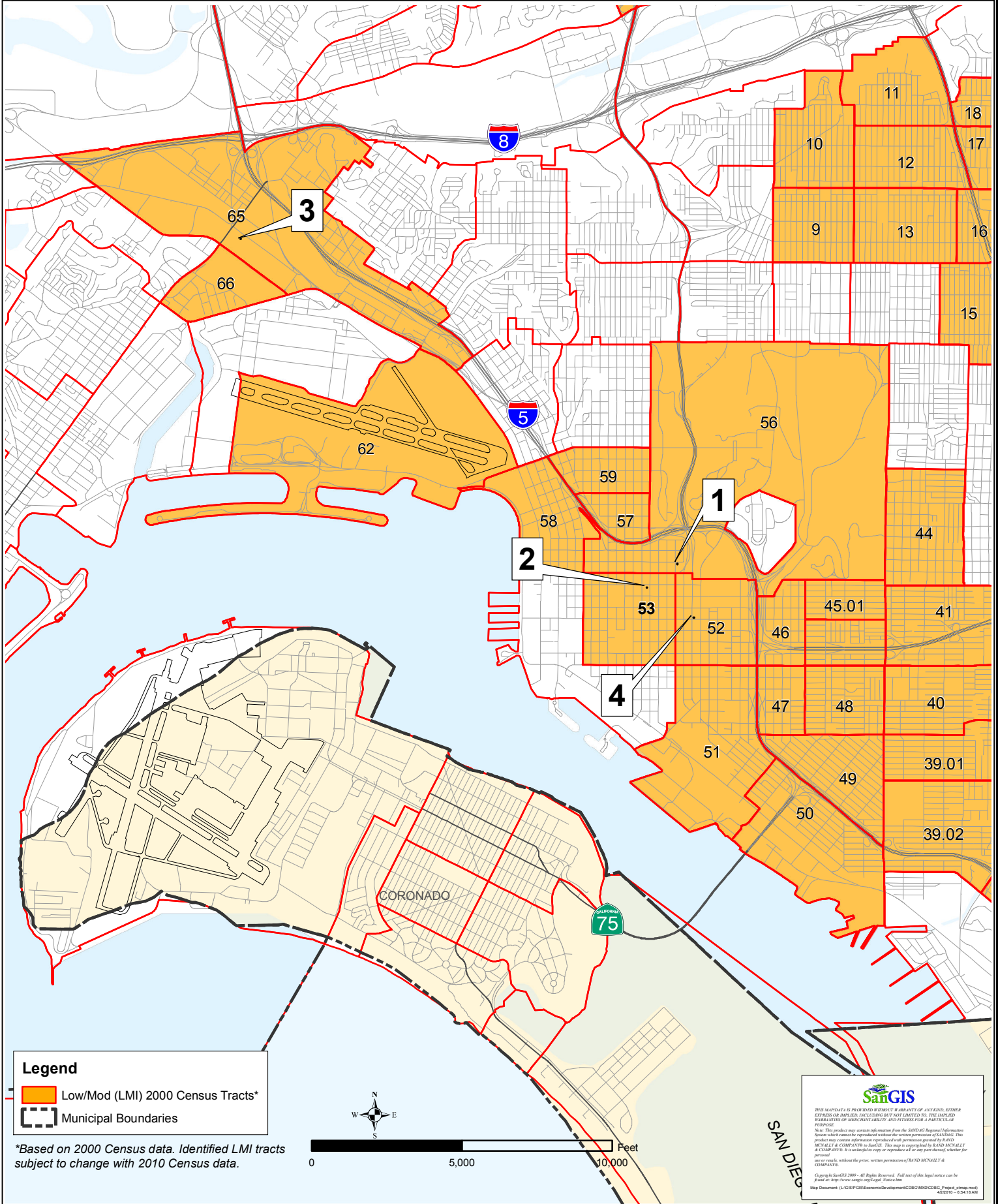


# FY 2014 ESG PROGRAM LOCATIONS RELATIVE TO LMI CENSUS TRACTS

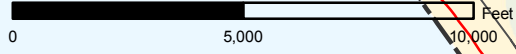

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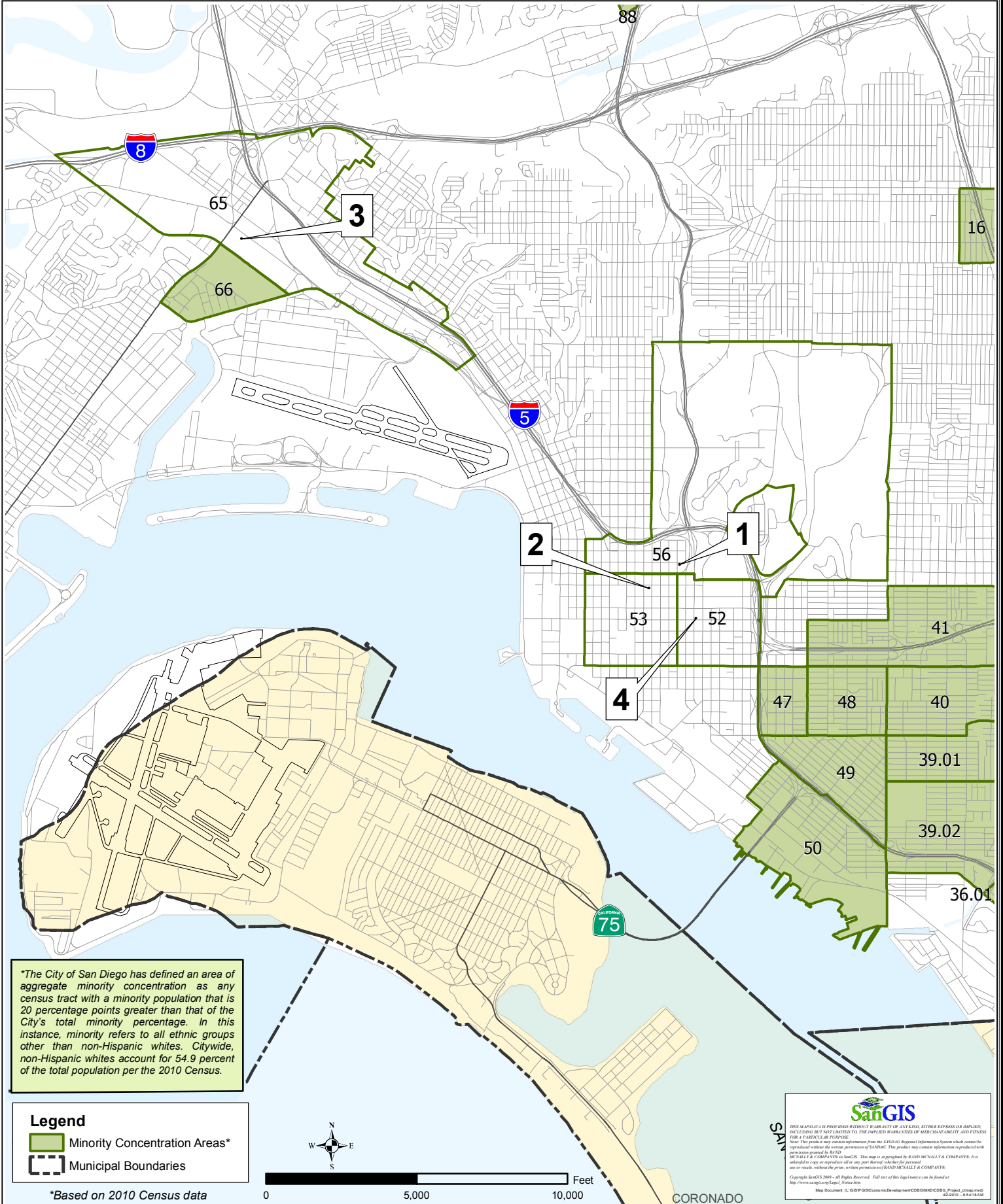


# FY 2014 ESG Program Locations Relative to Areas of Minority Concentration\*

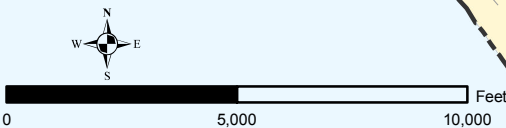

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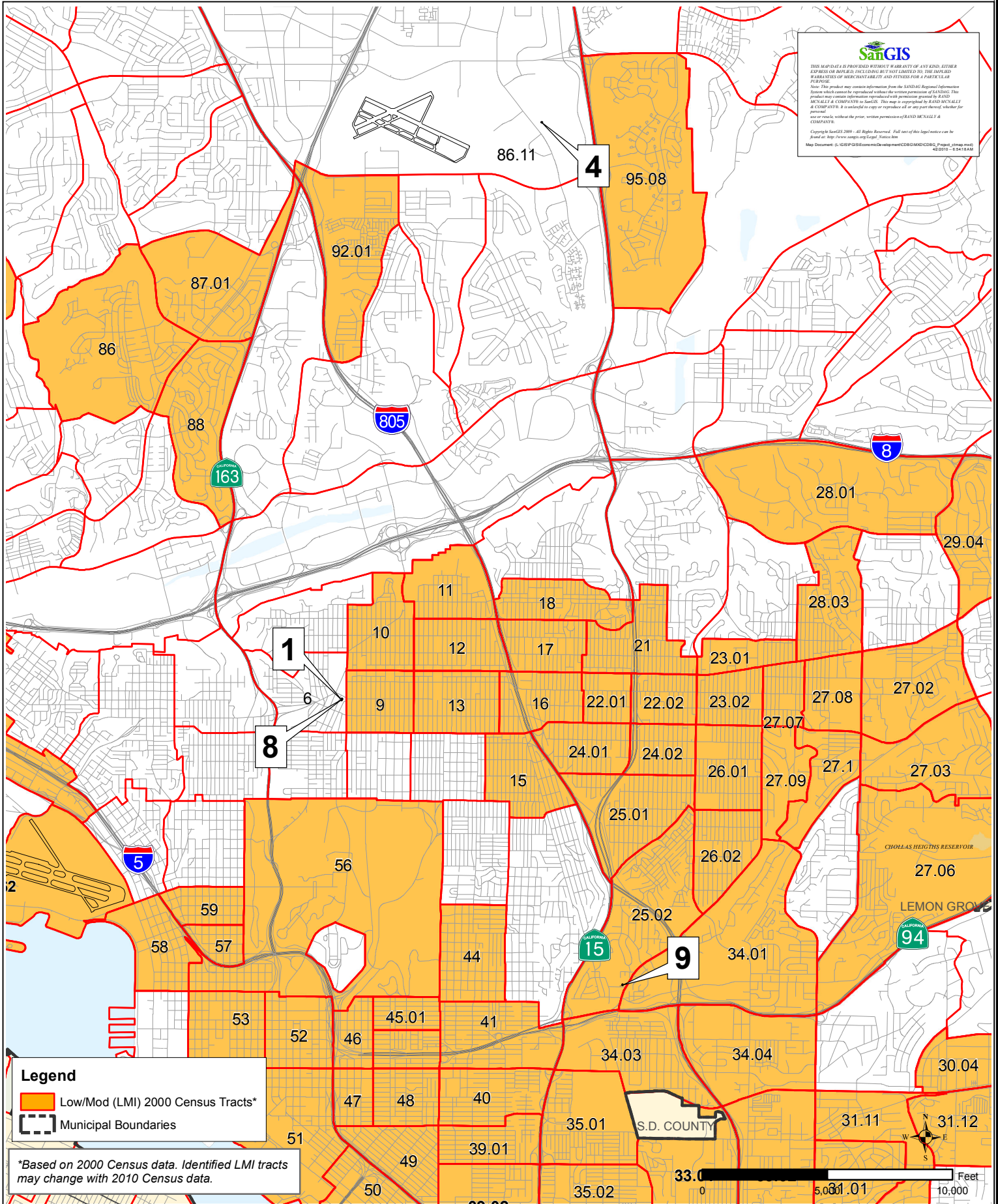


# FY 2014 HOPWA PROGRAM PROJECT SITES

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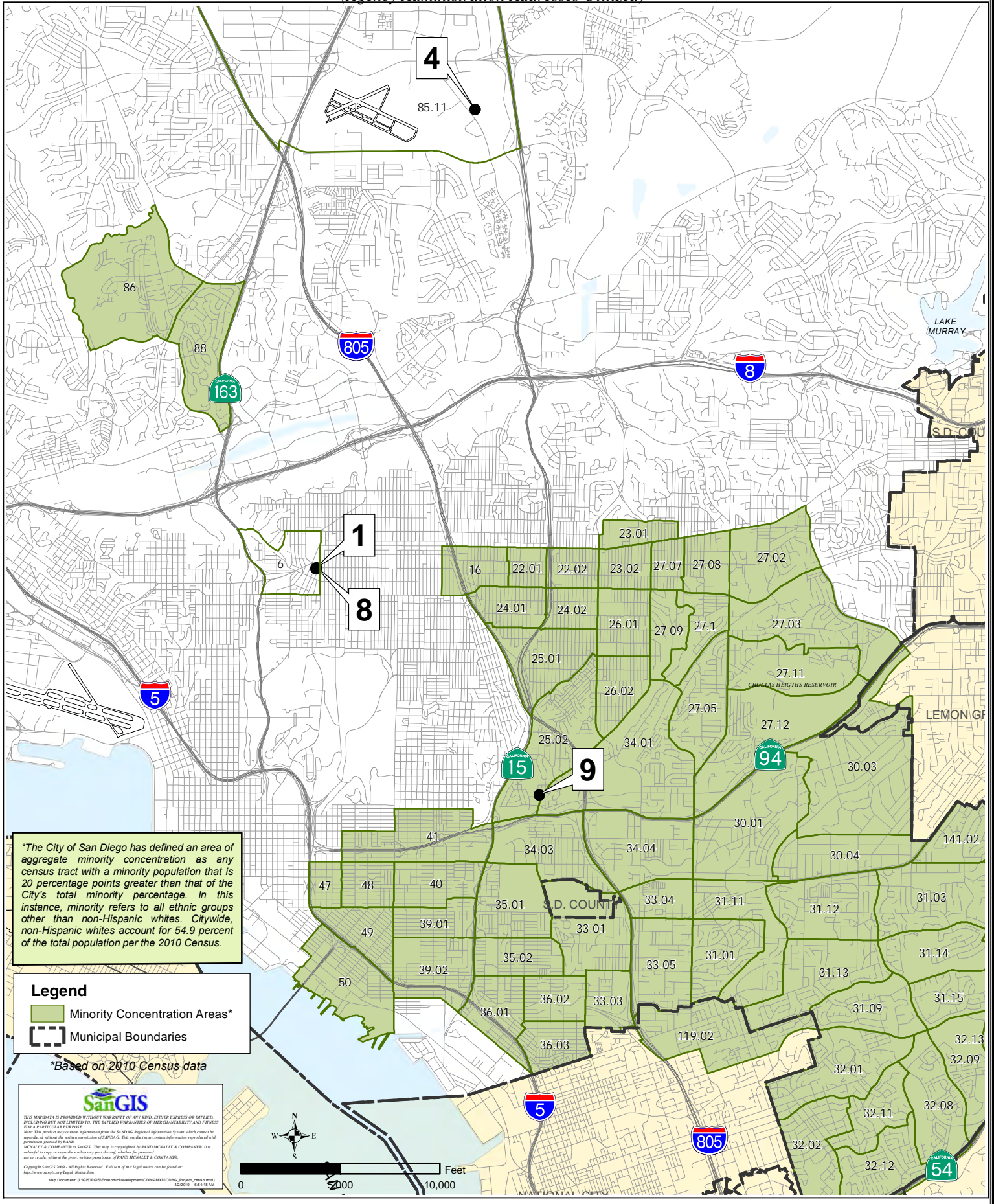

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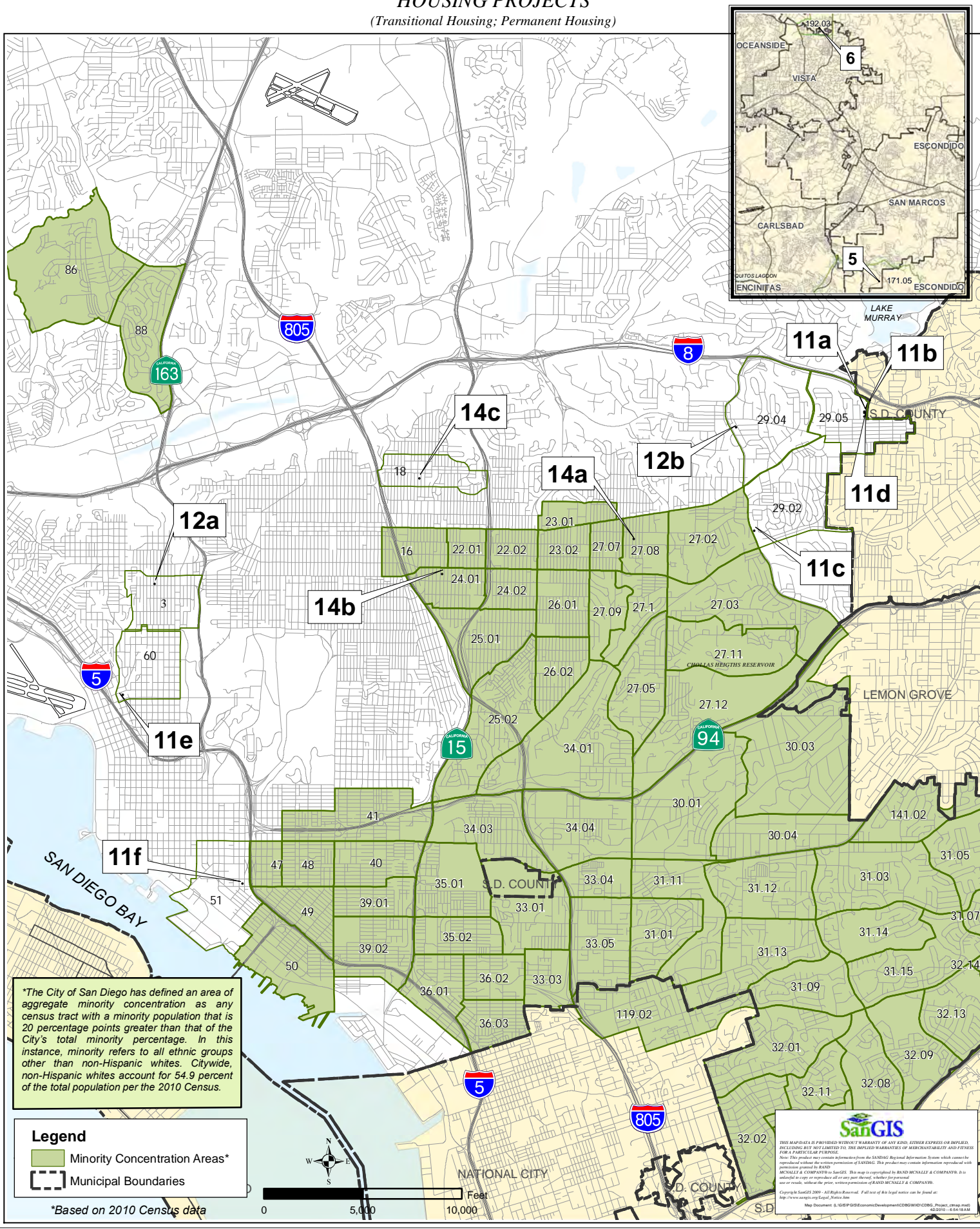


# FY 2014 HOPWA Program Relative to Areas of Minority Concentration\*

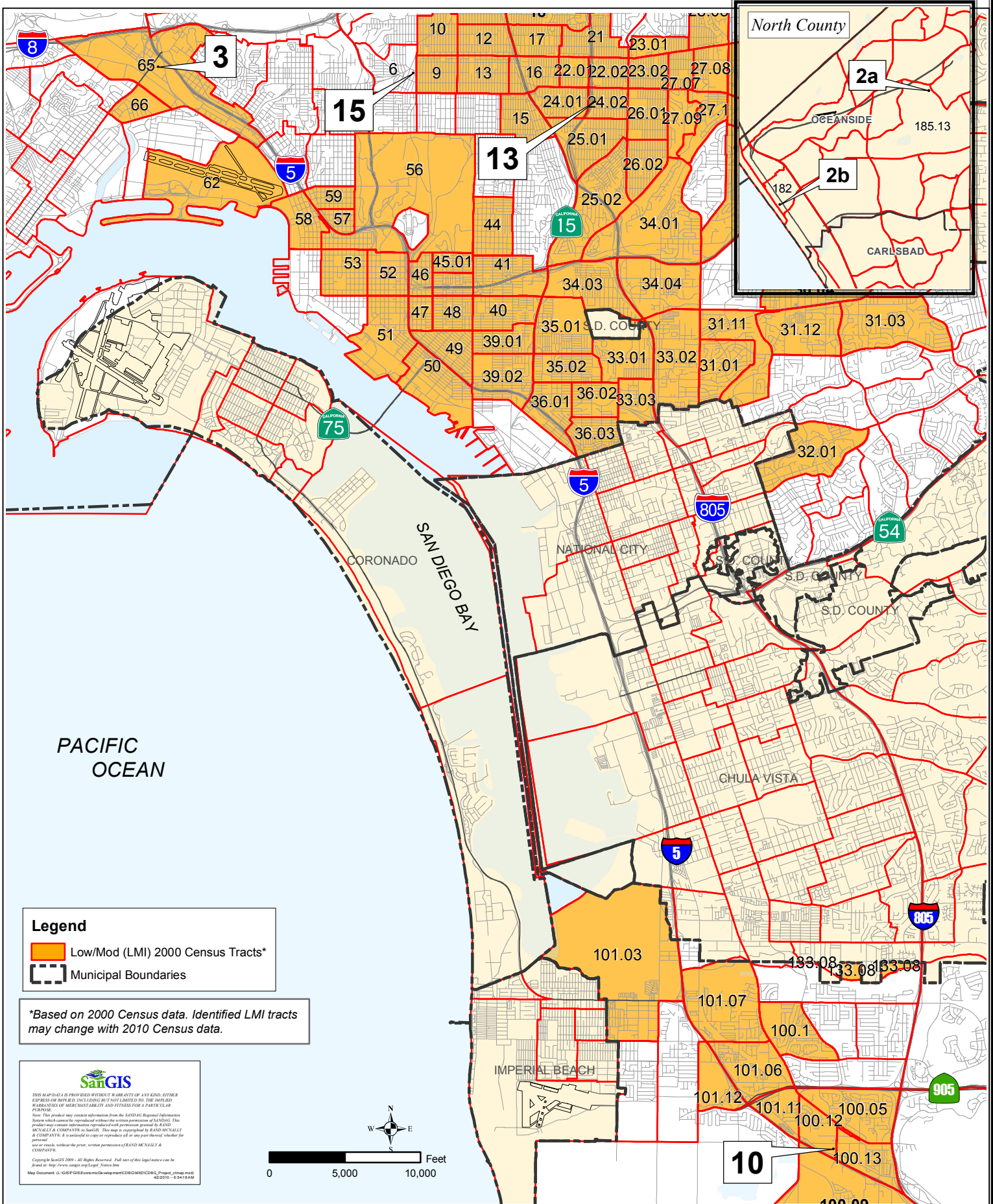
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# FY 2014 HOPWA PROGRAM PROJECT SITES

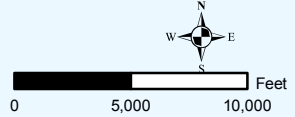
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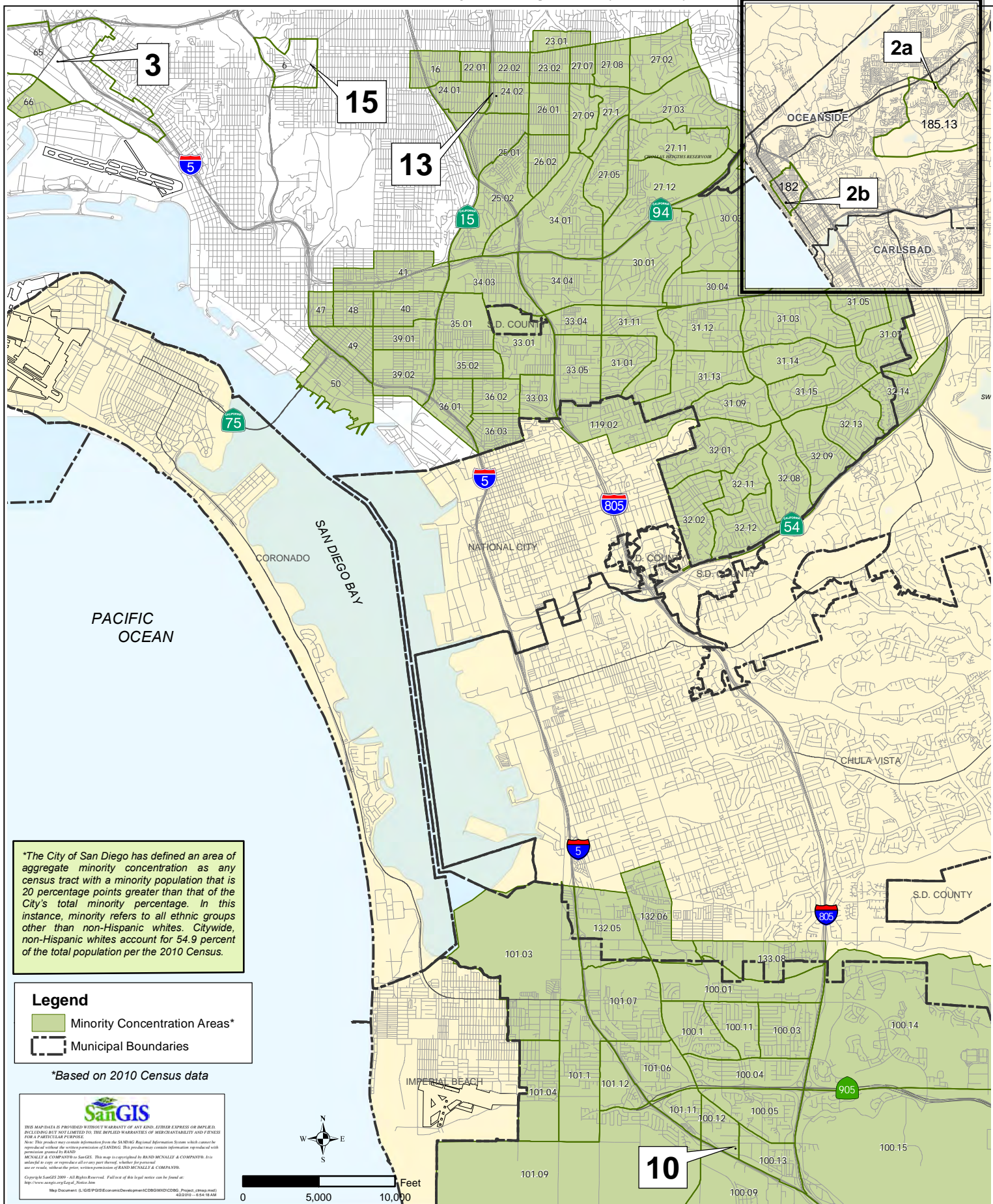
