The scope of the Balboa Park 2015 Centennial Celebration has been revised such that a general construction moratorium in the public right of way is no longer needed. The previous notice dated April 4, 2012 is hereby rescinded. Construction projects in the vicinity of Balboa Park will be reviewed on a case by case basis to avoid conflicts with scheduled events once the schedule is released. New construction projects should still take into account the possibility of conflict with events when planning construction schedules during the Centennial Celebration (Dec 2014 to Jan 2016).



The Balboa Park 2015 Centennial events are scheduled to take place starting in December 2014 and ending in January 2016. Therefore, to accommodate the volume of people attending events in the park, there will be a construction moratorium during this period beginning December 1, 2014 and ending January 15, 2016. Attached is a map identifying the moratorium area. The moratorium prohibits construction in the public rights-of-way including travel lanes, parking lanes and pedestrian walkways.

Construction in the right-of-way within the moratorium area will only be allowed on an exception basis, if work can be accomplished within periods when no events are scheduled. Applications for exceptions will be processed through the existing Traffic Control Permit process and will be subject to approval of the City Engineer. The schedule of events for the celebration will be published later this year.
