The Engineering & Capital Projects Department is holding a Community Meeting in order to provide information to residents in La Jolla about the Avenida De La Playa Infrastructure Replacement Project.

As part of a State designated Area of Special Biological Significance (ASBS), pollution and other discharges are prohibited in the waters off La Jolla Shores. This project is one of a series of projects to address storm water and urban runoff to comply with these regulations. Due to the undersized storm drains on Avenida De La Playa, frequent flooding occurs. This project will replace and realign approximately 1,300 linear feet (0.24 miles) of existing storm drain main and upgrade the existing outfall structure. In an effort to consolidate resources, this project will also replace approx 1,200 linear feet of sewer main and 150 linear feet of water main.
