Dear Interim Mayor Gloria and Members of the City Council:

I support closing Casa Beach in La Jolla during the five months of harbor seal pupping season between December 15 and May 15. As you know, the Federal Marine Mammal Protection Act and the San Diego Municipal Code protect wildlife at this location.

Of the 17 mainland seal rookeries in California, only Casa Beach and Bolinas Lagoon in Marin County have no access restrictions during pupping season.

Closing this beach during pupping season will protect seal mothers and newborn seal pups from human harassment. Unfortunately, harassment and encroachment from people results in premature births, abandoned pups and increased pup mortality. An abandoned harbor seal pup cannot survive without its mother.

It is for these reasons that I encourage you to close Casa Beach during the critical months of seal pupping season.

Closing this beach during pupping season will protect seal mothers and newborn seal pups from human harassment. Unfortunately, harassment and encroachment from people often result in the seals flushing into the water, which causes them to expend energy needlessly while preventing them from gaining the benefits of hauling out. When pups are on the beach, they can be injured or even killed by stampeding adult seals.

Biologists have observed that the presence of people on the beach near the hauled out seals typically results in large numbers of seals flushing. Dear Interim Mayor Gloria and Members of the City Council:

As many of you know, I was very involved in the effort to protect the harbor seal rookery for a five-year period, first starting in 2005 by volunteering a raking a line in the sand to discourage people from getting too close to the seals. Since then they have gotten more protection, but more needs to be done. As past president of La Jolla Friends of the Seals, we met with your staff and proposed closing the beach during the critical pupping season from December 15 through May 15. People still get too close to pregnant seals during the last trimester of their pregnancies which often results in premature births in which the pups often don't survive. After the pups are born, people getting too close may lead to pup abandonment. If the pups are lucky, they may be rescued by Sea World, but if not, they die.

I am still in support of that position. Of the 17 mainland seal rookeries in California, only Casa Beach and Bolinas Lagoon in Marin County have no access restrictions during pupping season. Casa Beach is the only urban beach where visitors and residents are able to see the seals so close up, and it has become a major tourist attraction for the City. Because of the possibility of getting so close to the seals, they are subject to unwary visitors getting too close. These people most likely would keep a safe distance if they knew what harm they are causing. Then there are others who feel it is necessary to harass the seals daily and disturb them in their natural environment despite the fact that they are protected by the Federal Marine Mammal Protection Act and other state and city ordinances protecting wildlife.

The only solution to this problem is closing the beach during pupping season. Why should we not take a proactive approach to ensure protection of these helpless animals? San Diego should be at the forefront instead of lagging behind. Aside from the pro-beach activists, the majority of the rest of the population supports such action.

It is for these reasons that I encourage you to close Casa Beach during the critical months of seal pupping season.
