### Conflict of Interest Code San Diego Festival, Inc.

#### A. Designated Positions:

Chair and members of the Board	1, 2, 3
Executive Director	1, 2, 3
Consultant*	1, 2, 3

#### B. Disclosure Categories:

1. All reportable investments and business position in any firm or business or a non-profit arts and cultural organization that supplies goods or services to the City of San Diego, that is a tenant of the City of San Diego, that is granted authority by the City of San Diego to use City facilities or that currently receives City funding, or that has in the past received City funding, or that may reasonable foreseeably apply for City fund in the future.
2. All reportable interests in real property owned or used by any person or business entity that supplies goods or services to the City of San Diego that is a tenant of the City of San Diego, or that is granted authority by the City of San Diego to use City facilities.
3. All reportable income, including gifts of fifty dollars (\$50) or more, from any person, business entity that supplies goods or services to the City of San Diego, that is a tenant of the City of San Diego, is granted authority by the City of San Diego to use City facilities or that is a non-profit arts and cultural organization (e.g., museum, theater, etc.) that does business in the City of San Diego that currently receives City funding, or has in the past received City funding, or may reasonably foreseeably apply for City funding in the future.

\* The Executive Director may determine in writing that a particular consultant, although a “designated position, “ is hired to perform a range of duties that is limited in scope and thus is not required to fully comply with the disclosure requirements described in this section. Such written determination shall include a description of the consultant’s duties and, based upon that description, a statement of the extent of disclosure requirements. The Executive Director’s determination is a public record and shall be retained for public inspection in the same manner and location as this conflict of interest code.
