APPENDIX B DISCLOSURE CATEGORIES

- Category 1 As required by Government Code Section 87200, designated positions in this category must file disclosure form 700.
- Category 2 Investment in, income from, or interest in any publicly-traded security which, during the reporting period, was held by any fund administered by the Funds Commission wherein the designed position's interest in said security amounted to one percent (1%) or more of the issue of that security.
- Category 3 Consultants shall be included in the list of designated employees and shall disclose pursuant to the broadest disclosure category in the code subject to the following limitation:

The Chairperson may determine in writing that a particular consultant, although a "designated position," is hired to perform a range of duties that is limited in scope and thus is not required to fully comply with the disclosure requirements described in this section. Such written determination shall include a description of the consultant's duties and, based upon that description, a statement of the extent of disclosure requirements. The Chairperson's determination is a public record and shall be retained for public inspection in the same manner and location as this conflict of interest code.
