APPENDIX B DISCLOSURE CATEGORIES

CATEGORY 1:

a.	All reportable investments and business positions in any firm or
•	business entity that supplies goods or services to the City of San
	Diego, or is granted authority by the City of San Diego to use City
	facilities.

- b. All reportable investments, business positions, and income from sources located in or doing business in the City of San Diego.
- c. All reportable interests in real property located in the City of San Diego, including property located within a two-mile radius of any property owned or used by the City.
- d. All reportable interests in real property owned or used by any person or business entity that supplies goods or services to the City of San Diego, that is a tenant of the City of San Diego, or is granted authority by the City of San Diego to use City facilities.
- e. All reportable income, including gifts, from any person or business entity that supplies goods or services to the City of San Diego, that is a tenant of the City of San Diego, or is granted authority by the City of San Diego to use City facilities.

CATEGORY 2: Consultants shall be included in the list of designated employees and shall disclose pursuant to the broadest disclosure category in the code subject to the following limitation:

The Mayor, or designated authority, may determine in writing that a particular consultant, although a "designated position," is hired to perform a range of duties that is limited in scope and thus is not required to fully comply with the disclosure requirements described in this section. Such written determination shall include a description of the consultant's duties and, based upon that description, a statement of the extent of disclosure requirements. The Mayor's, or designated authority's, determination is a public record and shall be retained for public inspection in the same manner and location as this Conflict of Interest Code.
