APPENDIX A
DESIGNATED POSITIONS, DUTIES AND CATEGORIES

<u>POSITION</u>	<u>DUTIES</u>	<u>CATEGORY</u>
<u>MANAGEMENT</u>		
Deputy Chief of Public Safety	Assist the Chief Operating Officer as required. Supervise the administration of the affairs of the Public Safety area except as otherwise specifically provided in the Charter; make recommendations to the Chief Operating Officer, Mayor and Council concerning the affairs of the City; keep the Chief Operating Officer and Mayor advised of the financial condition and future needs of the City; prepare the budget; see that the ordinances of the City and the laws of the State are enforced; perform other duties prescribed by Charter, ordinance or Council resolution.	1
Executive Director, Commission on Gang Prevention	Manage, plan and direct the operations of the Commission on Gang Prevention and Intervention, provide assistance and guidance to management, City Council committees and the community.	2
<u>CONSULTANTS</u>		
Consultant	Perform consultant services for the Office of Homeland Security.	3

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**APPENDIX B
DISCLOSURE CATEGORIES**

Category 1

Investments and business positions in any business entity either located in or doing business with the City of San Diego.

Income and gifts from sources located in or doing business with the City of San Diego.

Interest in real property located in the City of San Diego, including property located within a two-mile radius of any property owned or used by the City. "Real property" does not include the home/primary residence of the filer.

Category 2

Investments and business positions in any firm or business entity that supplies goods or services to the City; that is a tenant of the City; that is an adverse party to the City in a legal proceeding; or is granted authority by the City to use City facilities.

Income and gifts from any person or business entity that supplies goods or services to the City that is a tenant of the City; that is an adverse party to the City in a legal proceeding; or is granted authority by the City to use City facilities.

Interests in real property owned or used by any person or business entity that supplies goods or services to the City; that is a tenant of the City, that is an adverse party to the City in a legal proceeding; or is granted authority by the City to use City facilities.

Category 3

Consultants shall be included in the list of designated employees and shall disclose pursuant to the broadcast disclosure category in the code subject to the following limitation:

The Deputy Chief or designated authority may determine in writing that a particular consultant, although a "designated position," is hired to perform a range of duties that is limited in scope and thus is not required to fully comply with the disclosure requirements described in this section. Such written determination shall include a description of the consultant's duties and, based upon that description, a statement of the extent of disclosure requirements. The Deputy Chief or designated authority's determination is a public record and shall be retained for public inspection in the same manner and location as this Conflict of Interest Code.
