Please support winter seasonal closure at Casa Beach during harbor seal pupping season, December 15 to May 15 annually.

Closing this beach during pupping season will protect seal mothers and newborn seal pups from human harassment. Unfortunately, harassment and encroachment from people often result in the seals flushing into the water, which causes them to expend energy needlessly while preventing them from gaining the benefits of hauling out. When pups are on the beach, they can be injured or even killed by stampeding adult seals.

Biologists have observed that the presence of people on the beach near the hauled out seals typically results in large numbers of seals flushing. By prohibiting the public from entering the beach, flushing incidents will be vastly reduced, thus preventing premature births, abandoned seal pups and increased pup mortality. An abandoned harbor seal pup cannot survive without its mother.

For all of these reasons, it is imperative that you vote to protect the La Jolla Seals by approving the seasonal closure of Casa Beach.

Dear San Diego City Council,

Please support winter seasonal closure at Casa Beach during harbor seal pupping season, December 15 to May 15 annually.

Closing this beach during pupping season will protect seal mothers and newborn seal pups from human harassment. Unfortunately, harassment and encroachment from people often result in the seals flushing into the water, which causes them to expend energy needlessly while preventing them from gaining the benefits of hauling out. When pups are on the beach, they can be injured or even killed by stampeding adult seals.

Biologists have observed that the presence of people on the beach near the hauled out seals typically results in large numbers of seals flushing. By prohibiting the public from entering the beach, flushing incidents will be vastly reduced, thus preventing premature births, abandoned seal pups and increased pup mortality. An abandoned harbor seal pup cannot survive without its mother.

For all of these reasons, it is imperative that you vote to protect the La Jolla Seals by approving the seasonal closure of Casa Beach.

Also, I would like to take a moment to tell you that I am in Pacific Grove where we have our own Harbor seal rookery. I am proud to say that our City has voted to protect our Harbor seals by closing the beach during the pupping season. I am also a docent and recently have spoken to many people who have been visiting our seal beach and have expressed their feelings regarding La Jolla. Many of these people are from your area and are very upset over what is happening to the seals. They tell me how refreshing it is to see a place that actually protects their seals and values life.....I drive more than 8 hours to visit your harbor seal beach.....I would not come to your city to see a children's beach. There is value in your seals both for your city financially and for your children to learn valuable lessons about wildlife, and the bonds between a mom and her pup. Invest in your seals, support your local docents and turn this tragedy of pups dying into an amazing learning event where schools and local groups can get together and enjoy a beautiful experience that only God can create.
