A request to approve a contract with Pierce Manufacturing to purchase Fire Apparatus for the San Diego Fire-Rescue Department.

STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt the following resolution:

Authorizing the Mayor, or his designee, for and on behalf of the City, to execute an Agreement with Pierce Manufacturing, for the purchase of various Fire Service Apparatus;

Authorizing the Chief Financial Officer to expend an amount not to exceed \$15,000,000 from Fleet Services Replacement Fund No. 720011 and \$1,300,000 from CIP S-00688, Fire Station No. 45 - E. Mission Valley, from the Mission Valley - Urban Comm. Fund No. 400135, solely and exclusively, to provide funds for Fire Service Apparatus for the first Contract year, contingent on approval of such funding in the Fiscal Year 2016 Budget, and provided the Chief Financial Officer first furnishes one or more certificates demonstrating that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit in the City Treasury;

Authorizing the Mayor, or his designee, to purchase additional Fire Service Apparatus through the Contract with Pierce Manufacturing after Fiscal Year 2016 in an amount not to exceed \$19,700,000 contingent on approval of sufficient funding in the City Budget in future fiscal years, and provided the Chief Financial Officer first furnishes one or more certificates demonstrating that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit in the City Treasury.

STAFF SUPPORTING INFORMATION:

FISCAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The total cost of all vehicle purchases is estimated to not exceed \$16.3 million in Fiscal Year 2016 and an additional \$19.7 million through 2020. Additional costs for upfitting each vehicles with specific tools, radios, etc., average approximately \$50,000 per vehicle; this work will be performed by City forces and is budgeted annually.

Funds for this purchase will be available in the Fleet Services Replacement General Fund (720011) and the CIP S-00688, Fire Station No. 45 - E. Mission Valley, in the Mission Valley-Urban Comm. Fund (400135). Replacement motive equipment funds are generated by annual assignment fees made by the benefitting departments to the Fleet Services Division.
