U.S. GRAND JURY SUBPOENA RELEASED BY CITY ATTORNEY

Subpoena issued on August 10, 2005

Under the California Public Records Act, news organizations have requested documents related to the U.S. Attorney's criminal investigation of the City of San Diego's financial disclosure practices and pension system.

Today, City Attorney Michael Aguirre released the latest U.S. Grand Jury subpoena to the news media. The subpoena, issued on August 10, 2005, requests a number of documents dated from January 1, 1996, to the present. Among these documents are emails, memoranda, drafts, draft disclosures, and minutes concerning San Diego City Council action, discussion, and review of proposed changes to the sewer user charge rate system.

The documents are to be made available to the U.S. Grand Jury by August 25, 2005.
