The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), as the lead agency for the California Environmental Quality Act process, is issuing a Notice of Preparation (NOP) of a project Environmental Impact Report/Statement (EIR/EIS) for the Los Angeles to San Diego via the Inland Empire Section of the proposed California High-Speed Rail System.

The Authority is issuing the NOP to solicit public and agency input into the development of the scope of the EIR/EIS and to advise the public that outreach activities will be conducted by the Authority and its representatives in preparation for the joint EIR/EIS.

The scoping meeting will be an **open house format** with experts available to address questions and give project information. Maps of anticipated alignments will be available for viewing. Attendees may arrive at **any time** between 3 and 7 p.m. to receive information and submit comments.

Attendees will have the opportunity to submit written comments with comment forms or verbal comments with a stenographer at the scoping meeting.
