



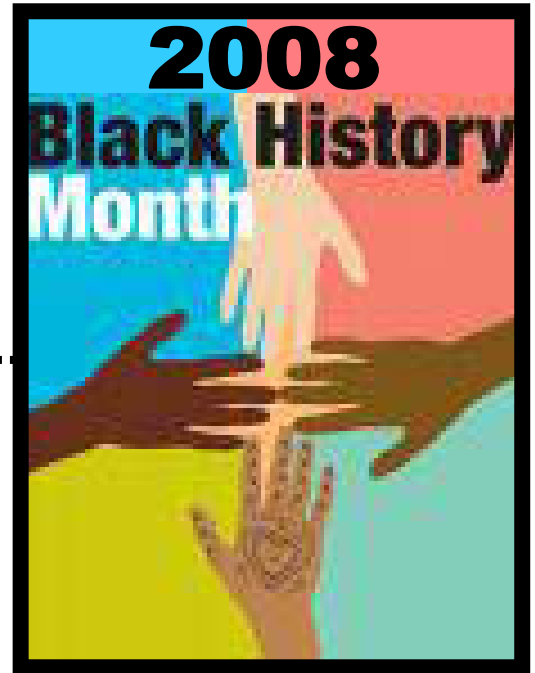

**COUNCIL ACTIONS:**

**On Monday, February 4, 2008 the San Diego City Council voted to place several ballot measures before the voters in the June 3, 2008 elections.** Ballot measures submitted for your review and vote include excluding public safety members from the managed competition process, making the strong mayor/strong council form of government permanent in 2010, and adding a 9<sup>th</sup> Council seat in 2010 (if the strong mayor/strong council measure passes).
