<sup>1</sup>**SBEP** - Small Business Enhancement Program, a citywide small business assistance program coordinated by the Office of Small Business.

<sup>2</sup>**CDBG** - Federal Community Development Block Grant funds obtained, allocated and managed by the City of San Diego. These funds are used for a variety of specified projects, ranging from business development and retention projects to streetscape and public improvement projects that directly benefit businesses and the community.

<sup>3</sup>**Morena** - Although technically still a BID, Morena business voted to eliminate the self-assessment fees.

<sup>4</sup>**El Cajon Boulevard** - CDBG funding of \$100,00 was awarded jointly to both Central and Gateway BIDs.
