

Renew Salon: Crossroads

What are the loan caps?

- A standard storefront with two or less units may be eligible for a loan of two-thirds the project cost up to \$20,000.
- Multiple storefront projects may be eligible for a loan of two-thirds the project cost up to \$40,000.
- Historic restoration activity increases the caps listed above by an additional \$10,000.

How is it different from the Citywide Storefront Improvement Program?

What is it?

The Redevelopment Agency aims to eliminate blight, create a positive visual impact, stimulate private investment, and complement other community revitalization efforts by offering an enhanced Storefront Improvement Program (SIP). Taking advantage of this program, participants are able to make a variety of improvements to their commercial building façades; such as new doors, windows, awnings, paint color, signage, and lighting.

Who can participate?

The program is open to property owners and business tenants in select redevelopment project areas managed by the City Redevelopment Department. A business tenant must have a minimum of five years remaining on the property lease at the time of project completion.

What are the benefits?

Design assistance consists of a brief meeting between the participant and a licensed architect to assess the building's exterior façade and discuss any potential design improvements. The result is a design concept sketch of the project.

Financial assistance is provided in the form of a forgivable loan. The amount of the loan may be up to two-thirds of the project cost, subject to certain caps. The participant

can opt to receive the loan at the completion of the project or a portion thereof during the construction of the project.
