### Construction Update

**I**n January 2009 the City of San Diego's Engineering and Capital Projects Department began construction on the new Rancho Peñasquitos Pump Station at 8888 Sparren Way. The final design of the project has been completed.

The portion of pump station construction taking place below grade is well under way, and the project scheduled to be completed by Spring 2010. As part of the pump station work, there will be minor grading and excavation taking place within the pump station site. Normal working hours for this project will be Monday through Friday, from 8am to 5pm.

Beginning April 18 2009, the contractor will perform excavation for several critical tie-in connections to the existing transmission pipelines and new pump station, requiring temporary 24-hour workdays to complete. The first tie in will be completed on April 19, 2009 at 6pm. Work on the next tie-in will begin April 28 2009, at 7pm and be completed on April 30 2009, at 8am.

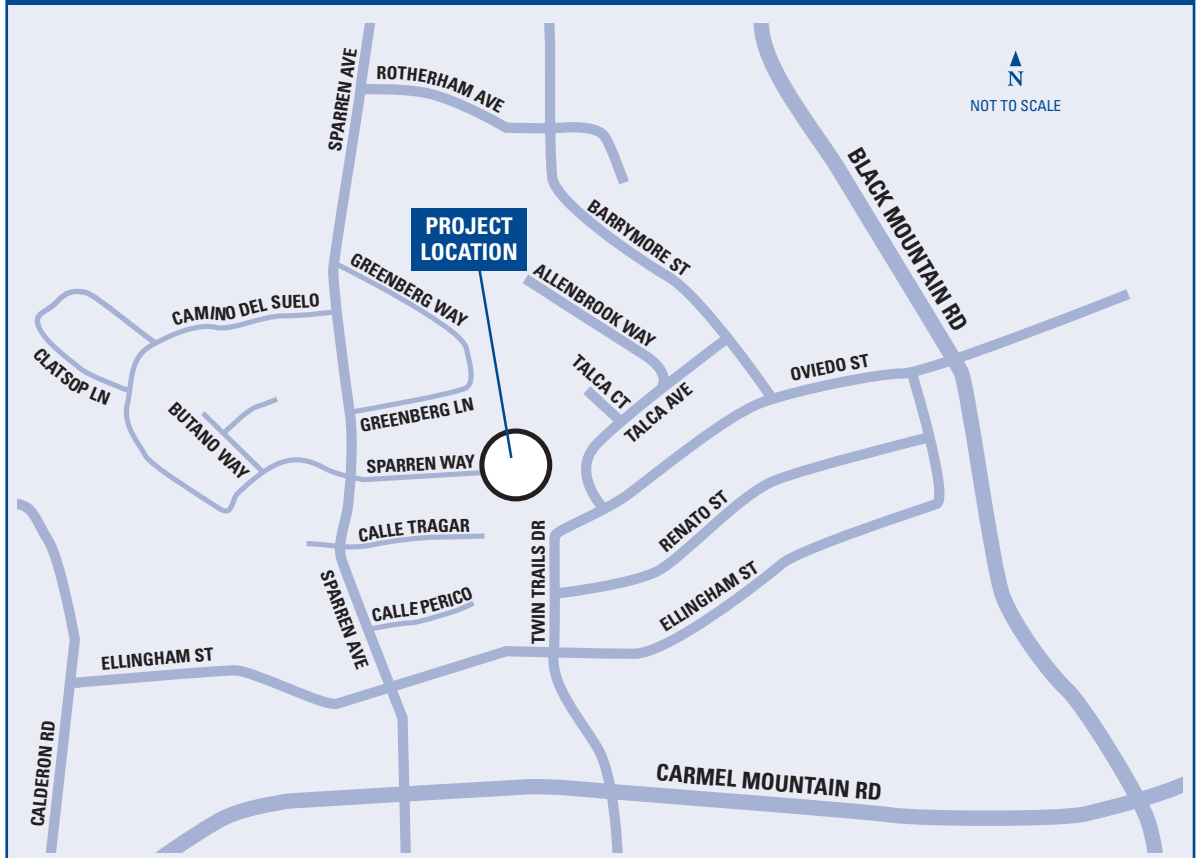

During this time, the surrounding community may experience noise and potential low water pressure within the system. However, there will be no interruption of water services. Temporary mitigation measures will be taken to minimize noise impacts and debris. Deliveries of materials will be limited to off-peak hours to minimize traffic to and from the pump station site.

Doorhanger notices pertaining to the tie-in connections have been distributed to the residents and surrounding community. One-on-one meetings between immediately impacted residents, the contractor and a city representative were conducted on March 26, 2009.



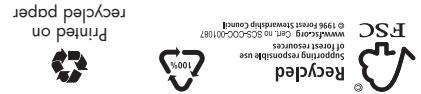

reduce noise, energy costs and improve service reliability in the northern service areas.
