## Miramar Landfill Clean Fill Dirt (Commercial) Program

The City of San Diego's Miramar Landfill, at times, has a need for clean fill material for use as daily cover and resurfacing of the tipping decks.

The cover material, when needed, must not be contaminated, and must be clean sandy, clayey soils and must not contain rocks larger than six inches in the largest dimension. It also cannot contain any concrete, asphalt, shot rock, organic debris or trash.

Material from each industrial/commercial project site (non-residential) must be approved by the landfill engineering staff prior to acceptance as "clean fill". A daily voice message recording is made available as to whether clean fill will be accepted that day.

The landfill staff reserves the right to reject and ban material from a project site if the material is found to be contaminated or unsuitable for the daily needs of landfill operations. Costs incurred by the City for managing contaminated or unsuitable soil including but not limited to staff time, equipment and materials, analytical testing, and disposal will be the responsibility of the party or parties responsible for the contaminated or unsuitable soil as determined by the City.

The City will not guarantee the right, or ability to freely dispose of clean fill material for any contractor's entire project. Clean material is accepted only on a day-to-day basis; operation's personnel may also cease the acceptance of clean fill material if the anticipated daily quantities for the day have been reached.
