Mission

The mission of the Office of the Chief Financial Officer is to provide the City of San Diego with the highest quality public services in the areas of financial management, budgeting, fiscal planning, and financial reporting to ensure financial integrity, maintain public interest, and promote accountability in government.

Group Description

The Office of the Chief Financial Officer (CFO) is the umbrella department under which all financial departments of the City are organized. The staff includes the Chief Financial Officer, the Director of Corporate Sponsorship, the Director of Major Gifts/Planned Giving, and an Executive Secretary.

The Office of the Chief Financial Officer oversees all of the City's financial activities. The following departments report to the Chief Financial Officer: City Comptroller, City Treasurer, Debt Management, Financial Management, Risk Management, and Purchasing & Contracting. The CFO is responsible for the City's internal controls over financial reporting and oversees the development and implementation of the internal control policies and procedures in all City departments.

The departments reporting to the Office of the CFO provide the following core financial functions for City: maintaining the financial records of the City; developing the City's financial statements; preparing annual budgets and long-range financial plans; developing debt financing proposals for borrowing funds; managing the City's investments, and collecting and tracking the City's revenues as part of the comprehensive City Treasury functions. The CFO's organization also includes the City's procurement and contracting functions, aimed at achieving cost-effective, ethical, and efficient procurement.
