- **Captain McElroy/Mckinney “Curfew Sweeps”**

Keeps teens out of the streets and the curfew sweeps requires people younger than 18 to stay off the streets between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m. The goal of this operation is to proactively enforce the curfew ordinance in an attempt to prevent the victimization of the youth in our communities as well as to educate parents/guardians of the importance of their children obey to the curfew ordinance.

- resources have been cut
- diversion has become critical factor
- People w/in community is making a difference
- curfew sweeps have been very successful (once a month)
- 8/9 divisions/ crime has decreased.
- 4wk session classes on drug awareness/gangs
- Curfew sweeps is not about arresting; it's about what's driving them into streets....

SCHOOL PREVENTION

- **Monica Tinajero: PASS**
“AMERICORP-SCHOOL COMMUNITY PROJECTS”
 - program is for students who have 2 or more unexcused absences, 1+ suspensions per year, low grades, gpa below 2.0, and 3+ referreals
 - provide individual/group mentoring

-implement research based curriculum lessons/activities with students

-plan/coordinate volunteer leadership opportunities at school and in the community with Pass and non pass students.

-maintain communication with school point of contact

Meet with teachers and communicate with PASS student parents

-maintain student attendance and student volunteer logs.
